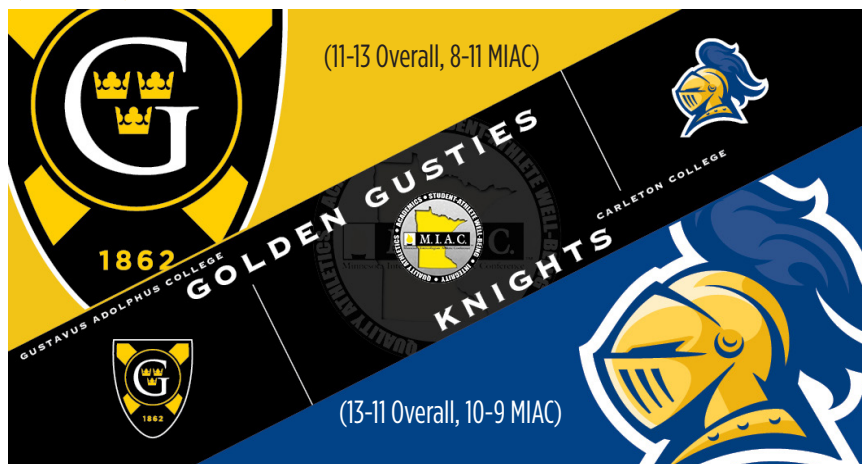

Setting The Scene: The Gustavus men's basketball team hosts its final game of the season at 1 p.m. Saturday for game two of the season series against Carleton. The Gusties enter the matchup with an 11-13 overall record and 8-11 mark in the MIAC, while the Knights are 13-11 overall and 10-9 in the league. Gustavus is coming off a thrilling 63-62 win over Saint John's, while the Knights lost 65-60 to Bethel on Wednesday.

Last Time Out: To say the past four games for the Gustavus men's basketball team have been exciting would just scratch the surface of describing them. Two overtime games and another decided on the last shot led to a similar ending Wednesday as the Gusties defeated Saint John's 63-62, taking the lead with four seconds on the clock on a Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) put-back, and then watching the Johnnies' final shot at the buzzer clank off the rim. The victory improves the Gusties to 11-13 overall and 8-11 in the MIAC, while the Johnnies fall to 17-7 overall and 12-7 in the league.

The first half play was sloppy on both ends of the court as Gustavus turned the ball over nine times compared to seven turnovers by the Johnnies. The Gusties also shot a pedestrian 28.6 percent (8-28) from the floor, including 3-of-11 from beyond the arc.

"I thought we defended them well in the first half, but offensively we didn't have much going," Head Coach Mark Hanson said. "They defended us well, but we didn't make them defend us long enough and we didn't make it a point to get it inside as much. We had a lot of three-point shot opportunities, we just weren't making them."

Saint John's jumped out to an early 14-2 lead in the first five minutes, taking advantage of Gustavus making only one of its first eight shots. The Johnnies led by as many as 13 points, twice, in the opening half, but the Gusties cut into the deficit with 10 unanswered points to make it a two-point game, 24-22, at the 4:00 mark. Saint John's responded right back with six unanswered points to end the half with a 30-22 lead.

Gustavus turned the momentum in its favor to start the second half with a 13-2 run. A pair of free throws by Peter Kruise (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) at the 15:49 mark gave the Gusties their first lead of the game at 35-34. Over the ensuing six minutes there were four lead changes and a tie, resulting in a 43-42 advantage for the Gusties. The Black and Gold maintained a slim advantage until a pair of free throws gave the visitors a 50-49 lead with 6:15 on the clock. From that point on, there were five ties and seven lead changes.

"We got the ball inside more and we got some things out of it," Hanson said of his team's second half performance. "Even our missed shots I thought were better. The one thing we didn't do well was shoot free throws and that could have made a big difference in the game."

After a Saint John's timeout and trailing 62-61 with 24 seconds remaining in the contest, Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) fired a three-pointer and missed, but Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) hauled in the rebound to reset the offense. Narum then looked for another opportunity for the go-ahead basket on the baseline, but his shot was off the mark. Ziegler then went up high for the rebound and made the put-back lay-in with just four seconds remaining to give Gustavus a one-point advantage. The Johnnies got off a last-second three-pointer, but the shot was no good, giving the Gusties the victory.

Ziegler finished with a game-high 20 points on 8-of-10 shooting from the field. He also made 4-of-7 from the free throw line and hauled in seven rebounds. Cooper recorded a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds. The senior wing also added four steals and two assists. Narum was the third Gustie to reach double figures with 10 points.

"Brody has had a pretty good year in all, statistically," Hanson said. "Some games better than others, but these last two I think he's played really well. Chris Narum has continued to play well. Chad Poppen seems more comfortable and is fully back from his injury. And hopefully we can finish up well on Saturday."

Gustavus finished the game shooting just 38.2 percent (21-55) from the floor, including 26.3 percent (5-19) from three-point range and 16-of-25 from the charity stripe. The Johnnies out-rebounded the Gusties 41-34, but committed more turnovers, 17-15.

Series Snapshot: Today's matchup marks the 89th meeting between Gustavus and Carleton in men's basketball. The Gusties lead the all-time series 54-34 and have won nine of the last 10 meetings, but that one loss occurred earlier this season in Northfield, Minn. in an overtime defeat.



Last Time They Met: Despite erasing a seven-point halftime deficit and forcing the game into overtime, the Gustavus men's basketball team was unable to hold off Carleton in the final five minutes, losing 64-53 on Jan. 16 in Northfield.

Carleton scored the first two points of the game and never relinquished the lead for the entire half. The Gusties kept the score close, though, as they played within seven points until a three-pointer by Carleton gave it a nine-point advantage with 1:10 remaining in the half. Playing in his first game since an injury on Dec. 2, Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) made a layup to close the first 20 minutes and the Gusties went into halftime with a 28-21 deficit. Cooper scored a team-high eight points in the first half.

Carleton maintained a four-to-nine-point lead for the first five minutes of the second, but Gustavus then scored 11 unanswered points to take a 39-35 advantage at the 9:08 mark. The scoring run was sparked by a pair of layups by Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.), followed by a Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) layup, Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) three-pointer and finally a layup by Cooper.

The Gusties held on to their lead until the 5:20 mark when a three-pointer put the Knights ahead 44-43. From the point on, there were four ties and three lead changes for the remainder of regulation. Cooper sunk a jumper with 1:37 on the clock to give the Gusties a 51-50 lead, but a free throw by the Knights tied the game and the two squads went into overtime tied 51-51.

Gustavus simply had trouble making shots in the overtime period as it went 1-for-8 from the field, and was forced to foul, sending the Knights to the charity stripe 14 times. Carleton made 8-of-14 from the free throw line en route to an 11-point victory.

Carleton shot 44.2 percent (19-43) from the field throughout the game, while the Gusties shot 36.1 percent (22-61). Three-point shooting proved to be a problem for the Gusties as they shot 1-for-23 from beyond the arc. Rebounds were close as Carleton won the battle 36-32.

Cooper led the Gusties with 20 points in his first game back from a seven-week injury. Ziegler also reached double figures with 11 points and was one-rebound shy of a double-double with nine boards.

About The Knights: Carleton enters today at 13-11 overall and 10-9 in the MIAC, which is tied for the sixth and final spot in the MIAC Playoffs. Tianen Chen leads the team off the bench, averaging 15.9 points per game. He is also the Knights' top free throw shooter at 74.7 percent (115-154). Kevin Grow leads the team down on the blocks, averaging 9.9 rebounds to go along with 13.9 points per game. The Carleton defense is stingy, allowing just 65.5 points per game, which is second best in the league.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1411-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-568, prior to the 2015-16 season. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 479 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 479-228 overall record at Gustavus, including a 362-157 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
