Setting The Scene: The Gustavus men's basketball team begins a three-game road trip with a tough test at 7 p.m. Wednesday for game two of the season series against St. Thomas. The Tommies won game one of the series $71-53$ on Jan. 6 in St. Peter. The Gusties enter the matchup with a 9-10 overall record and $6-8$ mark in the MIAC, while the Tommies are $17-1$ overall and 12 - in the league. Gustavus is trying to extend a four-game winning streak, while St. Thomas has won 13 straight. The Tommies' lone loss was on Dec. 5 against Carleton.

Last Time Out: The Gustavus men's basketball team continued its winning ways Saturday afternoon at Gus Young Court, cruising to a 92-67 victory over Macalester College. The Gusties claim their fourth straight and improve to 9-10 overall and 6-8 in the MIAC, while the Scots fall to \(3-16\) overall and 1-13 in the league.

Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) Ied the Gusties with 22 points, shooting a perfect 7-for-7 from the field, including 6-0f-6 from three-point range, 2-of-2 from the free throw line and a team-high six rebounds.
"He's been a 42 percent three-point shooter the whole year, so this isn't new," Head Coach Mark Hanson said of Narum's performance. "So when he makes six threes that grabs your attention, but he's been a good shooter all year."

Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) was also a big contributor to the Gustavus offense as he scored 18 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field, including a season-high seven assists. Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) and Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) reached double figures as well with 11 points apiece. Collectively, the Gusties shot 66 percent (35-53) from the field, which is a season high, including a season-best 71.4 percent (10-14) from beyond the arc.

Gustavus scored the first points of the game and never looked back. An 11-5 advantage at the 16:15 mark dwindled down to two points two minutes later, but the Gusties answered right back with a 10-2 run to take a double-digit lead. Macalester once again battled back and brought the score within three points at \(33-30\) with \(3: 42\) remaining in the half and Gustavus went into the locker room at halftime with a 40-34 advantage.

Gustavus continued to add to its lead in the opening minutes of the second frame. Macalester would cut the lead to seven points ( \(50-43\) ) at the 13:46 mark, but from that point forward, the Black and Gold shot lights out, converting 13 of its next 15 shots over an 11-minute span, leading to a 25 -point victory.

Gustavus won the battle of the boards, out-rebounding the Scots 33 -24 and had more assists, 20-18. The Gusties also took care of the ball, surrendering only eight turnovers, which is the second fewest all season.
"I like our effort today, but we need to be a little smarter in some places, such as defending screens," Hanson said.

Series Snapshot: Wednesday's matchup marks the 188th meeting between Gustavus and St. Thomas in men's basketball. The Tommies lead the all-time series 113-74 and are \(12-2\) in the past 14 meetings. The last meeting between the Gusties and the Tommies on Gus Young Court was Jan. 6, 2016 where St. Thomas won 71-53.

Last Time They Met: The Gustavus men's basketball team suffered its second loss of the New Year against N . 4 University of St. Thomas On Jan. 6 at Gus Young Court.

The Gusties went back and forth with the Tommies in the first five minutes of the game, scoring seven points for a three-point advantage, but couldn't hold down the Tommies offense as they went on a \(12-4\) run, leading the Gusties \(28-15\) with 2:58 remaining in the half. The Gusties fought back, narrowing the lead to 34-27 at halftime.

The Gusties cut the deficit to seven at the 10:53 mark in the second half on a jumper by Brian Jacobs (Sr., Lake Crystal, Minn.), but the Tommies responded with nine unanswered points and led by double digits for the remainder of the game. St. Thomas grabbed its largest lead of the game at \(71-46\) with \(1: 50\) remaining en route to a 18-point victory.

Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) led the team offensively as he was the only Gustie to reach double-digit figures with 10 points on 4-0f-6 shooting, and added two free throws. Alec Koster (JJ., Redwood Falls, Minn.) Ied the Black and Gold after the first half with seven points and four rebounds, followed by senior teammate Chris Narum (Eagan, Minn.) with eight points including two from long range.

Grant Shaeffer and Taylor Montero led the Tommies offense with 16 points each.
St. Thomas shot 55.3 percent opposed to the Gusties who were limited to 42.6 percent. The Tommies forced 20 turnovers compared to seven on the other end.

About The Tommies: St. Thomas was picked No. 1 in the MIAC Preseason Coaches' Poll and it has lived up to its expectations thus far. The Tommies are 17-1 overall and 12-1 in the MIAC, and are ranked No. 5 in the nation according to the latest D3hoops.com Top 25 poll. The Toms' lone loss of the season was a 67-66 shocker against Carleton on Dec. 5. Since then the Tommies have won 13 straight. Their most recent victory was a 67-61 decision over Macalester last Wednesday. After 18 games this season, four players average double digit points - Cortez Tillman (14.9), Taylor Montero (14.5), Grant Shaeffer (13.6) and Ryan Saarela (12.3). Saarela is a huge presence down on the blocks as he averages 8.9 rebounds per game along with 1.6 blocks per game.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1411-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of \(935-568\), prior to the 2015-16 season. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 477 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

\section*{Head Coach Mark Hanson}

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an \(89-78\) win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 477-225 overall record at Gustavus, including a \(360-154\) record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
