Setting The Scene: The Gustavus men's basketball team continues its road trip at 1 p.m. Saturday for game two of the season series against Concordia. The Cobbers won game one of the series 82-74 on Jan. 2 in St. Peter. The Gusties enter the matchup with a 9-11 overall record and 6-9 mark in the MIAC, while the Cobbers are 13-7 overall and 10-5 in the league. Gustavus has won four of its last five games, while Concordia has won eight of its last nine.

Last Time Out: The Gustavus men's basketball team suffered an 87-72 loss to No. 5 St. Thomas on Wednesday night, snapping a four-game win streak. It was a tale of two halves for the Gustie offense as it shot 33.3 percent (8-24) in the first, and 69.2 percent (18-26) in the second. The Gusties fall to 9-11 overall and 6-9 in the MIAC, while the Tommies extend their win streak to 14 with an overall record of 18-1 and a 13-1 mark in the league.

After starting the game down 0-2, Gustavus scored five unanswered points on a layup from Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) and a three-pointer by Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.), but that would be the last lead of the game for the Gusties as the Tommies responded with a 15-2 run and never looked back. St. Thomas held Gustavus scoreless for a four-minute span and went into the locker room at halftime with a 47-23 advantage.

The Tommies maintained a comfortable lead for the first seven minutes of the second half, leading by at least 16 points during that span, but the Gusties would not go quietly and answered with a 13-5 run to cut the deficit to 11 (64-53) at the 9:37 mark. The Tommies kept the Gusties at bay, though, not giving up their double-digit lead en route to a 15-point victory.

Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) led the Gusties offensively with 18 points off the bench, tying a season-high. Sharbono was 5-of-8 from the field, including 3-of-5 from beyond the arc. Cooper and Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) also reached double figures with 12 and 10 points, respectively.

Gustavus shot 52 percent (26-50) from the floor, while the Tommies shot 57.1 percent (36-63). St. Thomas out-rebounded the Gusties 32-25 and committed 12 turnovers to Gustavus's 13. All five starters for St. Thomas scored double digits, led by Taylor Montero with 16 points.

Series Snapshot: Saturday's matchup marks the 178th meeting between Gustavus and Concordia in men's basketball. The Gusties lead the all-time series 113-64 and are 7-4 in the past 11 meetings, but have lost three straight.

Last Time They Met: The Gustavus men's basketball team erased a double-digit deficit in the second half Jan. 2 against Concordia, but was unable to hold on to the lead en route to an 82-74 loss at Gus Young Court.

"We battled back a couple times and put ourselves in a position where if we made some stops we could continue the momentum, but Concordia was able to answer with another run," Head Coach Mark Hanson said. "Offensively we started to force some things and tried to make things happen partly because we weren't making stops."

Concordia shot lights-out to start the game, making its first nine shots from the field and led by as much as 10 points in the first five minutes, but the Gusties fought back and brought the score within three points at 24-21 at the 11:38 mark. Over the next seven minutes the Cobbers turned it back on as they went on a 16-5 run and led 44-34 at halftime.

The Cobbers were sufficient from the field in the first 20 minutes, shooting 73.1 percent (19-26), while the Gusties shot 50 percent (12-24).



Concordia led by as many as 10 and as few as six points in the first eight minutes of the second half until the Gusties score eight unanswered points to come within one point at 55-54 midway through the period. The run was sparked by a Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) jumper, followed by an Alec Koster (Jr., Redwood Falls, Minn.) three-pointer and another three from Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.).

The Cobbers maintained a slim advantage over the next two minutes, but a layup, foul, and a successful and-one opportunity by Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) gave Gustavus its first lead of the game at 61-60 with 7:41 to play. The lead was short-lived, though, as Concordia regained the advantage on the ensuing possession and never looked back the rest of the way.

Three Gusties reached double figure scoring – Narum (13), Peter Kruise (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) (12) and Poppen (11). Kruise and AJ Hatchett (So., Powder Springs, Ga.) led Gustavus with five rebounds each, and Koster distributed a team-high four assists.

Concordia shot 64 percent (32-50) from the floor, while the Gusties shot 44.8 percent (26-58). Concordia's Jordan Bolger led all scorers with 23 points.

About The Cobbers: Concordia is one of the hottest teams in the MIAC as it sits in second place in the league standings with a 10-5 record. The Cobbers have won eight of their last nine games in the conference with the most recent victory, 60-45, over Carleton on Wednesday in Northfield, Minn. Jordan Bolger leads the team as he averages 18.9 points, 8.3 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game, along with a 59.1 shooting percentage from the field. Those numbers make him a strong candidate for the conference MVP. Tom Frasse and Austin Nelson also average double digit points at 13.2 and 10.8, respectively.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1411-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-568, prior to the 2015-16 season. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 477 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGroot is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGroot returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGroot played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 477-226 overall record at Gustavus, including a 360-155 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
