Last Time Out: Last weekend. Gustavus tied and lost against the No. 10 ranked University of St. Thomas. Friday night in Mendota Heights, Minn., the Gusties and Tommies skated to a 2-2 overtime draw. First-year goaltender Bailey Jackson posted 41 saves, the most by a Gustie goalie since 1998. On Saturday, St. Thomas downed the Gusties by a score of 3-2 as Gustavus received goals from Kaitlyn Klein and Allie Stanger.

Series Snapshot: Friday's game marks the 42nd all-time meeting between the Gusties and the Auggies. Gustavus owns a 32-8-1 record over Augsburg and is 9-0-1 against the Auggies over the last five seasons. Last season, the Gusties tied and won against the Auggies.

About the Auggies: Augsburg is rolling on a five-game winning-streak after dropping its season opener. Last weekend, the Auggies swept St. Catherine University with 2-1 victories each night. Senior forward Callen Naasz leads the Auggies in scoring with two goals and two assists, while first-year forward Mikayla Jones is the leading goal scorer with three on the season. Junior goaltender Rebecca Sonnek has started four of five games and owns a 1.08 goals against average.

Gustavus Embarks On 20th Season Of Women's Hockey: The Gustavus women's hockey team is currently in its 20th season. Founded in 1997, the Gusties have attained an all-time record of 394-113-32, which stands as the second winningest program in all of NCAA Division III women's hockey. The Gustie women have won 13 MIAC titles in the 19 years of women's hockey in the conference. Those 13 titles rank first in front of St. Thomas (4), Augsburg and Saint Mary's, who each have two. Gustavus has also earned the MIAC Playoff crown a total of 11 times, 10 of which have come in the past 12 years and led to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances.

Wearing The "C": In the 19-year history of the Gustavus women's hockey program, 39 players have earned the honor of being a captain. This year, Diana Draayer and Allie Lewis return to earn that title and they add Erica Power.

Home Grown Talent: Of the 26 players on this year's roster, 22 are natives of Minnesota. The only players who reside outside the State of Hockey are Courtney Bethune, who hails from Fort Frances, Ontario, Allie Lewis, who is a native of Kearney, Nebraska, Amanda DiNella from Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois, and Tegan Rodriguez, a native of Sioux City. Iowa.

Scorers Return: Despite losing its top scorer from its 2015-16 squad, Gustavus will return 72 percent of its scoring from last season, including its second leading scorer in two-time All-Conference honoree Erica Power. Katy Fuller and Diana Draayer also return, having combined for 12 goals and 25 points.

First-years Featured: Through the first four games of the season, a third of the Gusties' scoring has come from the freshman class. Kristen Cash, Taylor Nelson, and Ameilia Vosen have all tallied their first goals in black and gold. Cash and Vosen also are tied for second in Gustavus scoring with a goal and assist each. Additionally, goaltender Bailey Jackson has started two games in goal. In her collegiate debut, she notched the most saves by a Gustie since 1998 as she she tallied 41 saves in an overime draw at St. Thomas.

Gustavus Notables:

- Emily Gustafson leads the Gusties in scoring with three points from two goals and an assist. Kaitlyn Klein has also recorded two goals, both on the power play and leads Gustavus with 14 shots on goal.
- The Gusties are ranked third among conference opponents in power play and penalty kill categories. Gustavus is 4-15 on the power play, good for a 26.7 percent mark while they allowed just one goal on the kill in 12 opponent chances.
- Gustavus has recorded the least amount of team penalty minutes in the MIAC with 28 minutes off 14 penalties.

Head Coach Mike Carroll

Mike Carroll is in his 18th season in 2016-17 as the women's head hockey coach at Gustavus. Within his tenure behind the Gustie bench, Carroll has turned Gustavus women's hockey into one of the most successful programs in NCAA Division III. He has compiled an overall record of 359-94-32 in 17 seasons and has the most coaching victories in the history of the program. Carroll is the second winningest coach all-time in NCAA Division III women's hockey with 359 wins and a winning percentage of .773.

Carroll has directed the Gusties to 12 MIAC regular season titles (2000-01, 2001-02, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14) and has been named the MIAC Coach-of-the-Year six times (2001-02, 2003-04, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2010-11, 2012-13). In addition to coaching 36 players who have earned All-Conference honors 64 times, he has coached six MIAC Players-of-the-Year in Sarah Garrison, Andrea Peterson, Stefanie Ubl, Allie Schwab, Lindsey Hjelm and Carolyn Draayer. Carroll has also worked with 14 players who have earned All-America distinction 22 times and two American Hockey Coaches Association Players-of-the-Year, including four-time MIAC Player-of-the-Year and four-time All-American Andrea Peterson.

Prior to coming to Gustavus, Carroll served as the head boys' hockey coach at Mankato West High School from 1991 to 1999. Carroll's college coaching resume included a stint as head men's hockey coach at Fergus Falls Community College from 1986 to 1987 as well as a season as the assistant men's coach at the University of St. Thomas in 1983. Carroll also ended a 19-year career as the head coach of the Gustavus baseball team in the spring of 2015.

Carroll, an Edina, Minnesota native, competed in hockey and baseball at Mankato State. After graduating with a degree in municipal recreation in 1982, Carroll played professional baseball in the Montreal Expos organization for two years. Carroll was inducted into the Edina High School Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012 and the Minnesota State University-Mankato Athletics Hall of Fame in 2013.

Mike and his wife, Terri, live in Mankato and have two sons, Matt and Mike.
