### SETTING THE SCENE

The Gustavus Adolphus College women's basketball team continues Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference play Saturday afternoon, traveling to Winona, Minn. to take on Saint Mary's Universitity. The Gusties enter with a 8-0 overall record while the Cardinals are 6-2 on the season.

Gustvaus most recently earned its eighth win of the season Wednesday evening, defeating the St. Olaf College by a score of 79-61 to remain undefeated. Mikayla Miller led the Gusties with 25 points and became the 11th all-time women's basketball player to reach the 1,000-point mark in her career.

### THE SERIES

Saturday's contest marks the 76th all-time meeting between Gustavus and Saint Mary's with the Gusties holding a 51-24 record over the Cardinals. Last season, Gustavus lost twice against Saint Mary's, last losing in in the MIAC Playoff Semifinals in Winona.

Scouting the CARDINALS Saint Mary's has begun the 2016-17 with a 6-2 record. The Cardinals most recently fell by a score of 69-56 against Bethel University on Wednesday. Saint Mary's averages 63.6 points per game and is led by sophomore forward Brandi Blattner, who is averaging 15.1 points per game and ranks second in the MIAC with an average of 9.4 rebounds per game.

#### **A STRONG TRADITION**

The Gustavus women's basketball team has compiled an all-time record of 665-448 making for a .597 winning percentage. The Gusties have won two MIAC titles, made five NCAA Tournament appearances, and have qualified for the conference playoffs each year since the initiation of the six-team MIAC Tournament in the 2000-01 season.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN The 2016-17 Gustavus women's basketball team is captained by senior forward Hannah Howard (St. Paul, Minn.), a co-captain from last year's squad.

#### HOME GROWN TALENT

Of the 16 players on this season's roster, 15 are natives of Minnesota. The lone player from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes is first-year Agnes Ekman, who is a native of Uppsala, Sweden.

#### SCORERS RETURN, ROOKIES INITIATED

With a strong core of returners, Gustavus returns 76 percent of its scoring, including 11 returners and five incoming first-years. That core also includes the Gustie's leading scorer from the two past seasons and two-time MIAC All-Conference recipient in Mikayla Miller (Jr., Goodhue, Minn.), last season's co-captain, Hannah Howard (Sr., St. Paul, Minn.) and All-Conference Honorable Mention honoree, Miranda Rice (Jr., Forest Lake, Minn.).

#### **GUSTAVUS NOTABLES**

- The Gusties' 8-0 start marks the best start of the season since the 2002-03 Gustavus squad began the season with a 13-0 record before suffering its first loss.

- The Black and Gold have outscored opponents by double figures in all eight wins this season.

- Gustavus ranks first in the MIAC in points per game (78.3), team field goal percentage (47.8), assists per game (19.1), and steals per game (15.1).

- In Wednesday's win over St. Olaf, Mikayla Miller (Jr., Goodhue, Minn.) scored 25 points to eclipse 1,000 points for her career. She becomes the 11th all-time Gustavus women's basketball player to reach the 1,000-point mark.

- Mikayla Miller leads the Gusties, averaging 18.3 points per game - which ranks tied for first in the MIAC.

- Miranda Rice (Jr., Forest Lake, Minn.) ranks among the top-five scorers in the MIAC, averaging 16.5 points per game. Her 63.5 field goal percentage is second in the MIAC. Hannah Howard (Sr., St. Paul, Minn.) ranks right behind Rice, shooting 63 percent from the field.

- Taylor Anderson (So., Rogers, Minn.) is 9-18 from three-point range this season, shooting 50 percent from beyond the arc to rank tied for second best in the MIAC.

Laurie Kelly begins her fifth season as head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus College women's basketball team in 2016-17. Kelly, a 1993 graduate of the University of St. Thomas with a degree in speech communications, came to Gustavus from Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff, where she directed the Division I Lumberjacks for nine seasons.

A Rochester, Minnesota, native, Kelly made a quick ascent through the Division II and I coaching ranks after a record setting Division III playing career at the University of St. Thomas in the early '90s. In nine years at Northern Arizona, she compiled the most wins in the program's history (117), while also directing the team to its first-ever Big Sky Conference tournament title and NCAA tournament bid in the 2005-06 season. During Kelly's tenure, the Lumberjacks advanced to the Big Sky tournament six times with two appearances in the championship game (2006, 2007), and her teams registered two of the three 20-win seasons in the program's history.



In addition to quality on the floor, her squads have also been strong in the classroom, with four players earning CoSIDA Academic All-District honors including one Academic All-American. Following the 2012-13 season, the Gustavus women's basketball team achieved a significant milestone when the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced its Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll following the year. Making their 15th appearance on the NCAA Division III honor roll, the Gusties were recognized as the team with the top cumulative grade point average in the country at a 3.60 – a first in the program's history. In addition, the Lumberjacks were recognized in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Top 25 Academic Honor Roll six times, with two Top Ten national rankings.

Prior to her position at Northern Arizona, Kelly coached at Binghamton University in New York and built the Bearcats into one of the top Division II programs in the country before helping the institution transition to a Division I program in 2001-02. In their first year of Division I competition, Kelly directed the Bearcats to a 19-9 record and a second-place finish in the America East Conference. During her five years at Binghamton, Kelly compiled a record of 94-22, including a mark of 75-13 in the program's final three years at the Division II level, and her squads won New England Collegiate Conference (NECC) titles in 1999 and 2000 and Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference (ECAC) titles in 2000 and 2001. She was named ECAC Coach of the Year in 2000 and New York State Coach of the Year in 2002. Kelly began her collegiate coaching career as the graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University, Mankato from 1996 to 1998. While she was at Minnesota State, Mankato she earned a master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in sports administration.

Before her success in the coaching ranks, Laurie Trow Kelly was a standout player at the University of St. Thomas from 1989 to 1993 and is recognized by many as one of the greatest players in NCAA Division III history. A gifted athlete, the 6-1 Kelly scored 2,607 points and pulled down 1,204 rebounds in four years, earning Kodak All-America honors three consecutive seasons. In her senior season (1992-93), Kelly was voted National Player of the Year by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association after averaging more than 26 points per game. She set 22 conference and 24 school records, was conference MVP three times, and was also named Midwest Sports Channel NCAA Division III Women's Athlete of the Year. In January 2006, Kelly was one of five players selected to the NCAA Division III 25th Anniversary Team.

Kelly is the ninth head coach in the history of the Gustavus women's basketball program. The Gusties have compiled an alltime record of 665-448 (.597), winning two Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championships and making five NCAA tournament appearances.

In addition to her coaching duties, Kelly serves as the coordinator of the Wellbeing for Employees (WE). The Wellbeing for Employees program offers employees at Gustavus a variety of educational opportunities, assessment tools, and physical activity experiences so that they can achieve and maintain a healthy lifestyle.

Kelly lives in St. Peter with and her husband, Matt, and their two daughters, Morgan and Madison.
