

Last Time Out: Last weekend, Gustavus earned a series sweep over St. Olaf College. The Gusties won 3-0 Friday in Northfield, followed by a 7-1 win Saturday at Don Roberts Ice Rink. Emily Gustafson (Sr., Esko, Minn.) scored twice in Friday's win, while seven different scorers told the story of Saturday's victory.

Series Snapshot: Friday's game marks the 40th all-time meeting between the Gustavus and Concordia women's hockey programs with the Gusties owning a 35-2-2 record over the Cobbers. Over the last five seasons, Gustavus holds a 8-1-1 record against Concordia. Last season the Gusties went 1-1 against the Cobbers, most recently falling 6-5 in Moorhead.

About the Cobbers: Concordia most recently split a series with Augsburg College last weekend, winning 4-1 and losing 5-3 against the Auggies. The Cobbers rank at the top of the conference along with Augsburg, each with a MIAC record of 8-2. They also rank first in the MIAC in goals per game (3.12) and power play goals (20). Senior forward Jess Nelson leads Concordia with 20 points off a MIAC-leading 13 goals and seven assists. Senior netminder Andrea Klug has started in all but one game and owns and is the MIAC leader in saves with 383. Klug also ranks among the top-five goalies with a 2.24 goals against average.

400 Milestone: On December 3rd at the College of Saint Benedict, a 3-2 win marked the 400th all-time victory in Gustavus women's hockey program history. The Gusties are the fastest team in the MIAC to reach the 400 mark.

Gustavus Embarks On 20th Season Of Women's Hockey: The Gustavus women's hockey team is currently in its 20th season. Founded in 1997, the Gusties have attained an all-time record of 394-113-32, which stands as the second winningest program in all of NCAA Division III women's hockey. The Gustie women have won 13 MIAC titles in the 19 years of women's hockey in the conference. Those 13 titles rank first in front of St. Thomas (4), Augsburg and Saint Mary's, who each have two. Gustavus has also earned the MIAC Playoff crown a total of 11 times, 10 of which have come in the past 12 years and led to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances.

Wearing The "C": In the 19-year history of the Gustavus women's hockey program, 39 players have earned the honor of being a captain. This year, Diana Draayer and Allie Lewis return to earn that title and they add Erica Power.

Home Grown Talent: Of the 26 players on this year's roster, 22 are natives of Minnesota. The only players who reside outside the State of Hockey are Courtney Bethune, who hails from Fort Frances, Ontario, Allie Lewis, who is a native of Kearney, Nebraska, Amanda DiNella from Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois, and Tegan Rodriguez, a native of Sioux City, Iowa.

Scorers Return: Despite losing its top scorer from its 2015-16 squad, Gustavus will return 72 percent of its scoring from last season, including its second leading scorer in two-time All-Conference honoree Erica Power. Katy Fuller and Diana Draayer also return, having combined for 12 goals and 25 points.

Gustavus Notables:

- The Gusties had seven different scorers in the 7-1 win over St. Olaf on Saturday.

- Tegan Rodriguez (Fy., Sioux City, Iowa) tallied her first collegiate goal on Saturday, while Diana Draayer (Jr., Deephaven, Minn.) and Laine Fischer (So., Northfield, Minn.) recorded their first goals of the season.

- Nicole Abraham (Fy., St. Paul, Minn.) posted a career-high two points with a goal and an assist Saturday. Erin Moes (So., Hastings, Minn.) also notched a career-high three assists.

- Emily Gustafson scored a career-high two goals to lead Gustavus to a 3-0 win last Friday at St. Olaf.

- Erica Power (Jr., Lakeville, Minn.) posted three points in the St. Olaf series and is now the Gusties' leading scorer with 11 points (4g-7a). Power is on a four-game point-streak with seven points (3g-4a).

- Gustie goaltenders Amanda DiNella (So., Oakbrook Terrace, III.) and Bailey Jackson (Fy., Chaska, Minn.) rank second and third in the MIAC in goals-against average. DiNella owns a 1.24 goals against average while Jackson averages 1.87.

Head Coach Mike Carroll

Mike Carroll is in his 18th season in 2016-17 as the women's head hockey coach at Gustavus. Within his tenure behind the Gustie bench, Carroll has turned Gustavus women's hockey into one of the most successful programs in NCAA Division III. He has compiled an overall record of 359-94-32 in 17 seasons and has the most coaching victories in the history of the program. Carroll is the second winningest coach all-time in NCAA Division III women's hockey with 359 wins and a winning percentage of .773.

Carroll has directed the Gusties to 12 MIAC regular season titles (2000-01, 2001-02, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14) and has been named the MIAC Coach-of-the-Year six times (2001-02, 2003-04, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2010-11, 2012-13). In addition to coaching 36 players who have earned All-Conference honors 64 times, he has coached six MIAC Players-of-the-Year in Sarah Garrison, Andrea Peterson, Stefanie Ubl, Allie Schwab, Lindsey Hjelm and Carolyn Draayer. Carroll has also worked with 14 players who have earned All-America distinction 22 times and two American Hockey Coaches Association Players-of-the-Year, including four-time MIAC Player-of-the-Year and four-time All-American Andrea Peterson.

Prior to coming to Gustavus, Carroll served as the head boys' hockey coach at Mankato West High School from 1991 to 1999. Carroll's college coaching resume included a stint as head men's hockey coach at Fergus Falls Community College from 1986 to 1987 as well as a season as the assistant men's coach at the University of St. Thomas in 1983. Carroll also ended a 19-year career as the head coach of the Gustavus baseball team in the spring of 2015.

Carroll, an Edina, Minnesota native, competed in hockey and baseball at Mankato State. After graduating with a degree in municipal recreation in 1982, Carroll played professional baseball in the Montreal Expos organization for two years. Carroll was inducted into the Edina High School Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012 and the Minnesota State University-Mankato Athletics Hall of Fame in 2013.

Mike and his wife, Terri, live in Mankato and have two sons, Matt and Mike.
