### **GAME NOTES**

#### **MEET THE HEAD COACHES...**

Head Coach Peter Haugen is in his ninth season at the helm of the Gustavus football program. Haugen, the 2015 MIAC Co-Coach-of-the-Year, has a combined record of 40-45 and is 28-39 in the MIAC. In the past four seasons, Haugen directed the Gusties to an overall record of 24-16. A graduate of Bethel University, Haugen was the head coach at Washburn High School in Minneapolis prior to coming to Gustavus.

Steve Johnson is in his 29th year as the head football coach at Bethel University. A native of Chicago, Johnson graduated from Bethel in 1979 before beginning his coaching career. Johnson made stops at St. Cloud State, St. Cloud Cathedral High School, the University of Minnesota, and Montana State before landing the Bethel job in 1989. He boasts a career record of 202-93-1 overall and ranks fourth among active NCAA Division III coaches in career wins.

THE SERIES... Saturday's game marks the 40th all-time meeting between the Gustavus and Bethel football programs, with the Royals holding a 22-17 series advantage. Last season, the Gusties fell 32-17 at Royal Stadium in Arden Hills, Minn. Bethel did all of its damage in the first half, scoring 12 points in the first quarter and 20 in the second, while holding the Gusties to a field goal for a 32-3 advantage at halftime.

**NEW-LOOK OFFENSE...** With the Gusties starting quarterback

Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) going down with an injury, the Black and Gold will look to use their other offensive weapons moving forward. Gavyn Walsh (Fy., Andover, Minn.) steps in to replace Veldman, having appeared in four games with eight completions and one touchdown pass. Limited to just the first three games in 2017 due to injury, Jamison Beulke (Jr., Montgomery, Minn.) returns to pace the Gustavus offense as a dual threat running back and receiver. Despite missing the previous two games, Beulke is still the Gustavus leader in rushing and all-purpose yards, having breakout games against Westminster and Augsburg. Against the Auggies, Beulke led the ground and aerial attack, establishing career-highs in both categories, while totaling 284 all-purpose yards. Beulke rushed 21 times for 99 yards with two touchdowns and brought in 14 receptions for 185 yards, earning MIAC Offensive Player of the Week honors.

#### **HAUGEN FACES ALMA**

MATER... Gustavus Head Coach Peter Haugen, a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, is facing his alma mater for the ninth time in his coaching career at Gustavus. Not only is Haugen facing his former team, but he is also facing his former coach in Steve Johnson. Haugen played for the Royals from 1987-to-1990 and was on Johnson's first team in 1989, when the Royals went 2-6-1. During his collegiate playing career, Haugen went 1-3 against the team he now coaches.



**DECKER GUIDES GUSTIE DEFENSIVE UNIT...** Senior outside linebacker and cocaption, Casey Decker (Mapleton, Minn.) ranks among the MIAC leaders in several defensive categories. Totaling 32 tackles (12 solo, 20 assisted) on the season, Decker leads the conference with nine tackles for loss and five sacks. In addition, Decker has tallied two pass breakups, two passes defended, two quarterback hurries, and one forced fumble. The most recent matchup at Concordia marked the first game in 2017 in which Decker did not pick up a tackle for loss or a sack. A vital member of the special teams unit as well, Decker plays an important role as the Gustie punter, totaling 777 yards on 22 punts, placing four inside the opponent's 20-yard line.

**BATTLING FOR MIAC UPPER ECHELON...** Saturday's game will determine which team will be near the top of the MIAC standings and remain in contention for a league championship. A Bethel win would propel the Royals above the Gusties in the standings and conversely, a Gustavus win would keep the Gusties in the top four at the very least. Coupling a Gustavus victory with a loss from either Saint John's or Concordia would put the Black and Gold in third place. St. Thomas will remain at the top with a 4-0 record and having a bye today.

#### **SCOUTING THE GUSTIES...**

After suffering its first Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference loss of the season to No. 16-ranked Concordia College by a score of 27-17 in Moorhead, Minn. on Sept. 30, the Gustavus Adolphus football team enters today's league showdown against Bethel University reenergized after the bye week.

Turnovers proved to be the difference in the 27-17 loss at Concordia. The Gusties led 14-10 at halftime, but the Cobbers were able to turn an interception and a fumble recovery into 14 points, while holding the visitors to a field goal in the final 30 minutes to secure the victory.

Through five games, Gustavus ranks as the No. 1 offense in the conference with an average of 444.6 yards of total offense per game, which has been guided by 1,666 yards of total passing yardage. However, with starting quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) out with an injury, the Gusties will lean more on the defensive unit as well as their other offensive weapons today against the Royals.

The Black and Gold receiving core has been a dangerous group, with four players owning at least 20 receptions. Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) has totaled 409 receiving yards and ranks fifth in the conference with an average of 81.8 yards per game. Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.) has been a red-zone threat for the Gusties, leading the team and ranking third in the MIAC with five touchdown receptions, followed by four from Kirk. After missing the previous two games with an injury, dual threat running back/wide receiver Jamison Beulke returns as one of the offensive leaders. In the first three games of 2017, Beulke

### MIAC WEEKLY AWARD WINNERS

### MIAC Co-Offensive Player-of-the-Week Jake Marsh, Bethel

#### Plymouth, Minn./Wayzata

Marsh was nearly perfect in Bethel's 49-0 Homecoming win over Carleton on Saturday, completing 22-of-25 passes for 320 yards and three touchdowns. His completion percentage of 88.0 is the highest for any MIAC quarterback in recent history with at least 25 attempts in a game.

#### MIAC Co-Offensive Player-of-the-Week Nick Barber, Hamline

#### Palm Bay, Fla./Heritage

Barber had a breakout game for the Pipers, hauling in 16 catches for 274 yards and four touchdowns in Hamline's 33-40 loss to St. Olaf on Saturday. Each mark ranks in the top-five all-time among MIAC single-game performances. His 16 catches is the third-highest single-game total and second-most in Hamline history, while his 274 yards and four touchdowns rank first in program history and second all-time in Conference lineage.

### MIAC Defensive Player-of-the-Week

#### Maple Grove, Minn./Maple Grove

Brant recovered two fumbles in the Tommies' 21-0 shutout of the No. 15-ranked Concordia Cobbers on Saturday. The junior linebacker returned one of those fumbles 24 yards to the Cobbers' two-yard-line, setting up a St. Thomas touchdown. Brant and the Tommies held Concordia to 108 total yards in the game and handed the Cobbers the program's first shutout in 11 seasons.

### MIAC Special Teams Player-of-the-Week Blake Hottle, Bethel

#### Waterloo, Iowa/Hudson

Kicker Blake Hottle went 7-for-7 on PAT tries in Bethel's 49-0 victory over Carleton on Saturday. He also averaged 41.5 yards on two punts and 58 yards on eight kickoffs in the contest. This is his second MIAC Special Teams Player of the Week honor this season.

recorded 204 rushing yards and 333 receiving yards along with three touchdowns.

Defensively, the Gusties have allowed an average of 296.4 yards of total offense per game, which ranks third in the conference. The defense has limited 168.2 passing yards per game, while surrendering 128.2 rushing yards per game. Co-captain outside linebacker Casey Decker has led the Gustavus defensive unit, leading the conference with five sacks and nine tackles for loss. Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) leads the team with 37 tackles along with one interception, followed by 33 tackles from Jake Boykin (So., Las Cruces, N.M.), and 32 from Decker.

#### SCOUTING THE ROYALS... The

Bethel University football team rolls into St. Peter looking to build on the momentum of last Saturday's 49-0 homecoming triumph over Carleton College at Royal Stadium. The Royals compiled over 650 yards of total offense while limiting the Knights to just 166. The passing game guided the Bethel offensive attack, as the Royals totaled 437 passing yards, while seven different Royals found the end zone.

After opening the 2017 season with three consecutive losses, Bethel has won two of its last three matchups, earning wins over St. Olaf and Carleton while falling at Saint John's. Averaging 404.7 total yards per game (4th/MIAC), the Royals rank fourth in rushing yards (130.8 avg.) and third in passing yards (273.8 avg.) per game. Sophomore

quarterback Jake Marsh has completed 63.1 percent (106-168) of his passes for 1,438 yards (239.7 ypg) and carries a touchdown-to-interception ratio of 10-to-6. Marsh ranks second in the MIAC in completion percentage and third in passing yards. Senior wide receiver Bryce Marquardt is Marsh's top target through the air, leading the MIAC with 20.9 yards per catch and ranking second in the conference with 544 receiving yards.

A young trio heads the Bethel ground game, with first-years Sam Gibas and Gideon Erhabor, along with sophomore Riley McCann leading the way. Gibas leads the Royals with 270 rushing yards, followed by 198 from McCann. Gibas and Erhabor each have four touchdowns.

The Royal defense has allowed an average of 314.3 yards of total offense per game, allowing 199.3 passing yards (4th/MIAC) and 115.0 rushing yards (5th/MIAC) per game. The secondary unit leads the defense as the Royals are tied for third in the MIAC with seven interceptions. Sophomore defensive back Cale Ferrin guides the defense with 39 tackles (21 solo, 18 assisted), while leading the team with three interceptions. Drew Ragsdale, Dawson Brown, and Brett Norling follow with 37, 35, and 32 tackles, respectively.

Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, enters his ninth year as head football coach at Gustavus Adolphus College for the 2017 season.

Last season, the Gustavus football team posted a 5-5 overall record with a MIAC mark of 3-5. The Golden Gusties started the season winning their first three games and averaged 36 points per game during the first four games. Twice the Gustie defense disallowed their opponent's offense to exceed double-digit points, defeating Westminster College 35-6 and St. Olaf College 23-3.

In the MIAC's 2016 post-season honors, first team all-conference recipients included offensive lineman Joe Theiler (Sr., Maple Grove, Minn.) and linebacker Casey Decker (Jr., Mapleton, Minn.). Second team members included running back Luke Martinez (Sr., Lenexa, Kan.), wide receiver Hunter Johnson (Jr., Cannon Falls, Minn.), offensive lineman Ryan Landherr (Sr., Prior Lake, Minn.), defensive lineman Chris Nelson (Jr., New London, Minn.), inside linebacker Jordan Kahlow (So., Le Sueur, Minn.), and kicker Brendan Boche (Jr., Lakeville, Minn.). In addition, linebackers Matt Berkner (So., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) and Leeland Lauti (Jr., Ewa Beach, Hawaii), running back Karim Ortiz (Jr., Cancun, Mexico), and defensive lineman Iker Ortiz-Hidalgo (Sr., Cancun, Mexico) earned honorable mention honors.

In eight seasons at the head of the Gustavus Adolphus football program, Haugen has compiled an overall record of 37-43 and a MIAC record of 26-38.

Haugen, who was the head football coach at Washburn High School for 15 years prior to coming to Gustavus, compiled an overall record of 111-44 during that span, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He has also served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football Conference and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early '90s. In his senior year, he earned all-conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Haugen became the 17th head coach in the 100-season history of Gustavus football in 2009. The Golden Gusties have a long and storied football tradition that includes 22 MIAC titles. The program ranks in the top-50 all-time in Division III (out of 235 institutions) with a 58.2 winning percentage (486–346–21). The Gusties will soon join an elite group of 53 NCAA Division III institutions whose football teams have won 500 games.

Along with great teams, Gustavus has also been blessed with many outstanding individual players, which includes 25 players who have received All-America honors, 13 who have received CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, and five who have received NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships.

### GUSTAVUS 38 WESTMINSTER 0

St. Peter, Minn. (475) Hollingsworth Field 75°, Sunny

**ST. PETER, Minn.** – The Gustavus football team used a balanced offensive attack and steady defensive play in its 2017 season opener, defeating Westminster College 38-0 on Saturday afternoon at Hollingsworth Field.

Four different Gusties found their way into the endzone, led by a three touchdown performance from quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.), twice completing to Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.).

"It is a good indicator, we have a lot of guys who can possess the ball and being able to spread the ball around is a good thing," Head Coach Peter Haugen commented on the offensive balance.

The Gustavus offense just needed four plays on its first drive of the 2017 season to gain a 7-0 lead as Jamison Beulke (Jr., Montgomery, Minn.) posted a career-long 58-yard run, avoiding Blue Jay defenders towards the edge and sprinting down the sideline for the touchdown with 11:27 left in the first quarter. Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) added a 33-yard field goal at the 3:24 mark and the Gusties owned a 10-0 lead after one quarter.

With just 20 seconds remaining in the first half, Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) found Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.) in the corner of the end zone for a 16-yard touchdown pass, Panning's first of his career as the Gusties took a 17-0 lead into halftime.

The offensive onslaught and defensive structure held throughout the second half as the Black and Gold notched their first shutout since the 2015 season, which was a 49-0 home-opening win against Lake Forest College.

Veldman completed another 16-yard touchdown pass to Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) for the Gusties sole score of the third quarter, pushing the lead to 24-0. In the fourth quarter, Karim Ortiz (Sr., Cancun, Mexico) added a two-yard touchdown run while Veldman and Panning connected for another touchdown pass near the corner of the end zone for the final score of the game as the scoreboard read 38-0.

The Gustavus defense held Westminster to just eight first downs and 153 total yards of offense through four quarters, led by a share of tackles. 19 Gusties recorded at least two tackles, led by Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.) with a career-high of nine,

including 2.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. Jordan Kahlow (Jr, Le Sueur, Minn.) also tallied two tackles for loss while Chris Nelson (Sr., New London, Minn.), Nick Jacques (So., Orono, Minn.), and Tanner Sparrow (Jr., Edina, Minn.) each contributed sacks.

"Our defense played well, it was good to get plenty of guys in there," said Haugen. "I'm really proud of them and our defensive coaches effort. I think it was a good first game for us, there are certainly some things we're going to have to work through, but all in all, we had good effort with a lot of different guys playing. The game plan was solid and is something we can build on."

Beulke led Gustavus with 91 rushing yards, 91 passing yards, as well as 182 all-purpose yards on the day. Veldman finished the game with 17 completed passes on 31 attempts for 290 yards.

Next weekend, the Gusties travel to River Falls, Wis. for another non-conference game against the University of Wisconsin-River Falls. Last season, Gustavus hosted the Falcons and came away with a 24-21 victory during the home opener. Kickoff is set for 7 p.m. on Saturday at Ramer Field.

"We're going to have to get better, UW-River Falls is a good football team and we were fortunate enough to win against them a year ago, but this year is a whole new story," Haugen concluded.

### UW-RIVER FALLS 20 GUSTAVUS 12

River Falls, Wis. (3,250) Ramer Field 69°, Partly Cloudy

**RIVER FALLS, Wis.** – The Gustavus football team was defeated 20-12 at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls on Saturday evening, as the Gusties wrapped up their non-conference action with a 1-1 overall record.

After a strong offensive output in the season opener a week ago, the Gustie offensive attack was hindered, as a ground-heavy Falcon offense put up 166 rush yards and limited Gustavus to just 29. Despite recording the most passing yards in a game since 2015 with 334, the Gusties were only able to come away with one touchdown and two field goals.

UW-River Falls relied on its rushing attack as they claimed a 14-3 lead in the first half. The Falcons led the Gusties with in rushing yards, 67-26, and ate up the clock, converting five of nine third down attempts. On their first opportunity of the game, UWRF used a 10-play, five minute drive. Michael Gibbons scored a 23-yard rushing touchdown to give UW-River Falls the first lead of the game with 7:18 remaining, where the score stood after the first quarter.

Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) was successful on a 32-yard field goal attempt that was the Gusties only score of the first half, as Gustavus trailed UW-River Falls 7-3 with 14:56 remaining in the second quarter. The Gusties and Falcons each traded a few possessions prior to UW-River Falls tacking on another touchdown, late in the first half. With just 57 seconds left in the half, Tim McCarthy hauled in an 11-yard touchdown pass to give the home team a 14-3 lead heading into the intermission.

Boche opened the scoring in the second half, making it a one-score game and cutting the UW-River Falls lead to eight with his second field goal of the game, a 38-yard field goal to complete a 15 play, 70-yard drive at the 6:19 minute mark of the third quarter.

The Gustie field goal was answered by the Falcons, keeping the ground-game steady with another rushing touchdown from Diggins to take a 20-6 lead near the end of the third quarter.

In the back-end of the fourth quarter, the Gustavus defense led an

effort to make a late push. With 9:16 left, the Gusties forced the first turnover of the game as the Black and Gold forced a UWRF fumble. However, Gustavus was unable to convert the turnover into points. In the next defensive drive, Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) recorded his first career interception and brought it back 37 yards as the Gusties had 4:20 remaining for a comeback. On the ensuing drive, the Gusties scored their sole touchdown of the game as Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) chucked a hail mary-like careerlong 42-yard pass to Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.), who brought in a great catch for his second score of the season. It wasn't enough, as UWRF ran down the clock to secure the 20-12 victory.

Berkner, Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.), and Dutch Claybaugh (Jr., Kaneohe, Hawaii) combined to lead the defensive effort, tallying eight tackles each.

Veldman completed 29 passes on 47 attempts, totaling a career-best 334 passing yards. Kirk led the receiving core with the sole touchdown and a career-high six receptions for 114 yards. Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.) also brought in a career-high 11 receptions for 84 yards.

Gustavus heads into Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference play next Saturday, heading to Minneapolis, Minn. to take on Augsburg College.

AUGSBURG 37 GUSTAVUS 42

Minneapolis, Minn. (1,046) Edor Nelson Field 73°, Mostly Cloudy

**MINNEAPOLIS, Minn.** – The Gustavus football team claimed a 42-37 victory over Augsburg University in its Minnesota Collegiate Athletic Conference opener on Saturday afternoon at Edor Nelson Field.

Guided by a strong start and offensive onslaught, the Gusties (2-1, 1-0 MIAC) totaled 532 yards of offense to take down the Auggies (2-1, 0-1 MIAC).

Gustavus opened the game recording four scores, led by three touchdown passes from quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) while the Gustie defense limited the Auggies to just one score, taking a 28-7 lead into the intermission.

On their second offensive drive of the game, the Gusties completed the sole touchdown of the first quarter, an eight-yard touchdown pass from Veldman to Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.), his third of the season.

The Black and Gold outscored Augsburg 21-7 in the second quarter, led by two more touchdown passes from Veldman along with a three-yard rushing touchdown from Jamison Beulke (So., Montgomery, Minn.). Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) brought in an eleven-yard pass for his third touchdown of the season, followed by Beulke's score to increase the lead to 21-0. After the Auggies' completed a 27-yard pass for their only score of the first half, Cam Hufendick (Sr., Minneapolis, Minn.) completed his first career touchdown with a four-yard reception as Gustavus took a 21-point lead into halftime.

"We were playing very efficiently on both sides of the ball," Head Coach Peter Haugen spoke of the Gusties' play in the first half. "Our defense also played very well in the first half. It was definitely a story of two halves, but at the same time we made some key conversions offensively to keep drives alive in the second half."

Triggered by a forced fumble, Augsburg stole the momentum out of the gate in the second half, compiling 17 points to cut the Gustie lead to 28-24 heading into the final frame. However, Gustavus maintained its lead as they matched Augsburg's score total. Each team scored twice in the fourth quarter, another receiving touchdown from Panning and rushing score from Beulke for the

Gusties. Down by one score, Augsburg's last chance to take the lead was taken away with an interception from Drew Fredericksen (Sr., Forsyth, Ill.), solidifying the victory.

Veldman finished with a career-best game, totaling the most passing yards by a Gustie quarterback since 2014, completing 35 passes for 430 yards and four touchdowns. Beulke also led the Gustavus offense with 284 all-purpose yards, registering career-high rushing and receiving totals. Beulke led the rushing game with 99 yards on 21 carries and carried the receiving core with 14 catches for 185 yards.

"He played well," Haugen spoke of Veldman's performance. "He made some really big throws and was extending plays with his arm. Beulke was the big story of the day, though."

Defensively, the Gusties were led once again by linebacker Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.), who totaled nine tackles, including 2.5 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, and one pass breakup. In addition, 10 other Gusties contributed tackles for loss. As a team, Gustavus totaled five sacks and 12 tackles for loss.

"There is so much to learn this week that will help us down the road. First of all, winning a close game in the end is just an invaluable experience. Making a huge play at the end of the game to win it, with the interception, is huge. Wins are hard to come by, so we are thankful to build on that," Haugen concluded.

### GUSTAVUS 51 HAMLINE 7

St. Peter, Minn. (3,893) Hollingsworth Field 83°, Partly Cloudy

**ST. PETER, Minn.** – The Gustavus football team totaled 566 yards of total offense and rolled to a convincing 51-7 homecoming victory over Hamline University on Saturday afternoon at Hollingsworth Field.

After Hamline snapped the Gusties' 10-game winning streak with a 42-40 win on its home turf a season ago, Gustavus came back with its highest offensive output since the 2015 season while totaling over 400 passing yards for the second game in a row.

Quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) finished with 392 passing yards, completing 26 passes on 42 attempts to go with his second consecutive four-touchdown performance. The receiving trio of Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.), Brayton Finch (So., Mount Morris, Ill.), and Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) combined for 340 receiving yards off 21 receptions.

The Black and Gold scored on its opening drive as Kirk converted a double reverse, taking a pitch from Nathan Schroepfer (Fy., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) for the 37-yard score. Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) added a 24-yard field goal to give the Gusties a 10-0 lead after the first frame.

Hamline opened the second quarter with its sole score of the game prior to the Gustavus offense answering on the next drive and opening up the flood gates. Veldman and the Gustie receiving core converted three touchdown passes to take a 31-7 lead into the intermission.

Veldman hit Finch for a career-long 81-yard touchdown pass, followed by a Johnson 11-yard touchdown, followed by Kirk's second score of the game and his fourth receiving touchdown of

the season. With the Johnson score, Gustie kicker Brendan Boche tallied his 99th career extra point made to pass Ryan Boutwell (1995-98) as the all-time extra points made leader.

Gustavus added three more scores in the second half while the defense kept the Piper offense at bay. Rafael Soriano-Campos (So., Guadalajara, Mexico) scored his first career touchdown from two yards out before Johnson picked up second touchdown reception of the game. The Gusties closed out their scoring in the fourth quarter as Gavyn Walsh (Fy., Andover, Minn.) connected with Greg Knaack (Jr., Burnsville, Minn.) for a 17-yard touchdown pass, their first career touchdowns.

Defensively, the Gusties limited the Pipers to under 200 yards and total offense and totaled 13 tackles for loss and five sacks. Jake Boykin (So., Las Cruces, N.M.) led the team with seven tackles. Ben Rengel (Jr., Sartell, Minn.) picked up two tackles for loss and a sack, while Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.) also tallied two tackles for loss, one sack, and one pass breakup.

### CONCORDIA 27 GUSTAVUS 17

Moorhead, Minn. (4,774) Jake Christiansen Stadium 65°, Sunny

**MOORHEAD, Minn.** – Turnovers proved to be the difference in a 27-17 loss for the Gustavus football team at No. 16 Concordia-Moorhead on Saturday. The Gusties led 14-10 at halftime, but the Cobbers were able to turn an interception and a fumble recovery into 14 points, while holding the visitors to a field goal in the final 30 minutes to secure the victory. Gustavus drops to 3-2 overall and 2-1 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, while Concordia remains unbeaten at 4-0 overall and 2-0 in the league.

Concordia outgained the Gusties 305-226 in yards from scrimmage, relying heavily on its ground game for 274 rushing yards. Gustavus posted a season-low 183 passing yards along with 43 rushing yards.

"Our guys played hard, and it was a tough game played on both sides of the field," Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "It all came down to a few plays and execution, but I'm proud of the way our guys battled today."

On the first play of the game, the Gusties were supplied a jolt of momentum as Austin Fest (Fy., West Des Moines, Iowa) forced a fumble on the opening kickoff return, which was recovered by Matthew Montplaisir (So., Buffalo, Minn.). The Gustavus offense took the field on the Cobber 27-yard line and the initial drive sputtered out and was forced to punt, but a personal foul gave the Black and Gold a fresh set of downs. Two plays later Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) found Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.) for a 26-yard touchdown – their third scoring connection of the season.

Both teams' next possession ended with a punt, but the Cobbers followed with an eight-play scoring drive, finishing on a 12-yard touchdown run and the score read 7-7 with 5:13 left in the first quarter. Gustavus took little time to answer as it drove 84 yards in eight plays, capped by a 36-yard touchdown pass from Veldman to Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.) and the Gusties led 14-7 with 1:59 remaining in the opening frame.

Each team ensued with three punts apiece before Concordia was able to generate an offensive drive late in the half. The Cobbers went 38 yards on nine plays, resulting in a 29-yard field goal to make the score 14-10, which stood at halftime.

The two squads traded short possessions to start the second half and Gustavus started its second drive of the third quarter from its own 25. Veldman nearly completed a 40-yard strike to Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.), but the pass fell incomplete. The following play, Veldman was intercepted and the Cobbers took it to the endzone for a 32-yard return and a 17-14 lead with 8:31 on the clock. Two possessions later, first-year quarterback Gavyn Walsh

(Fy., Andover, Minn.) entered the game for an injured Veldman and guided the Gusties into Cobber territory, setting up a 44-yard field goal by Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) to tie the game 17-17 early in the fourth quarter.

Concordia answered on the next drive, going 30 yards on six plays, capped by a 32-yard field goal to regain the lead 20-17 with 10:12 remaining in the game. The back-breaker for the Gusties came next as they fumbled the kickoff return, which was recovered by the Cobbers at the 23-yard line. Four plays later, the home team found the endzone on a four-yard rush and took a 27-17 advantage with 8:39 to play.

The Gusties wouldn't go quietly, though, as Drew Fredericksen (Sr., Forsyth, Ill.) returned the ensuing kickoff 79 yards down to the Cobber 15-yard line, but a quick three-and-out followed by a missed 25-yard field goal kept the score at a 10-point difference. Gustavus forced a Concordia punt on the next drive, but was unable to generate any more offense and time ran out on a potential comeback bid.

Veldman finished the game 16-of-31 for 163 yards with two touchdowns and an interception in just over two quarters of play. Walsh came in and completed 5-of-8 passes for 20 yards. Karim Ortiz (Sr., Cancun, Mexico) was the leading rusher with 55 yards on 19 carries, while Johnson was the top receiving target by hauling in seven catches for 54 yards and a score. Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) paced the defense with a career-high 14 total tackles. The Gustie defense was stout on third down, limiting the Cobbers to one first down in 10 attempts.
