## 2017-18 GUSTAVUS MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

## SETTING THE SCENE

The Gustavus men's basketball team is set to continue Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference play, hosting St. Olaf College on Saturday for a 1:00 p.m. tipoff at Gus Young Court. The Gusties own a 3-2 overall record along with a 1-0 conference record, while the Oles are $3-0$ overall and 1-0 in the conference.

## THE SERIES

Saturday's game marks the 154th meeting between Gustavus and St. Olaf on the hardwood, with the Gusties holding a 95-58 advantage in the all-time series. The Oles are currently riding a 10 game win streak against Gustavus and swept the Gusties with 69-65 and 72-56 victories last season.

## LAST TIME OUT

Gustavus opened conference play at Gus Young Court on Wednesday, defeating Saint Mary's University 85 -65. The Gusties shot 30 -for- 62 from the field and out-rebounded the Cardinals by a mark of $48-25$ in their highest offensive output of the season in the 20-point victory. Four out of five Black and Gold starters scored in double figures, with Jason Faul (Sr., Prior Lake, Minn.) leading the way with a career-high 21 points, shooting 8-12 from the field.

## ABOUT THE OLES

St. Olaf is unbeaten early on in its 2017-18 campaign, opening the season with non-conference wins over the Univeristy of Wisconsin-Stevens

Point and UW-Eau Claire prior to opening its MIAC schedule with a $59-44$ win over Macalester College on Wednesday.

The Oles have particularly been strong defensiveIy, holding their opponents to an average of 50.0 points per game, a 31.8 field goal percentage, and a 24.1 three-point field goal percentage, which all rank first in the conference. Sophomore guard Nate Albers leads the St. Olaf offense with an average of 15.0 points per game, shooting 10-for-22 from the field and $7-16$ from beyond the arc. Junior forward Austin Korba has brought in 24 rebounds, averaging 8.0 per game (5th/MIAC).

Mark Hanson is in his 28th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2017-18 season. During his time as head coach, Hanson has directed his teams to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 485-250 overall record at Gustavus prior to the 2017-18 season, including a 367-174 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament
six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 30 players who have garnered 50 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached two Jostens' Award Finalists (Trevor Wittwer, 2008; Marc Newell, 1999), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a threetime Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter and has two children, Hans and Annika.
