GAME NOTES

FOLLOW THE GUSTIES ON KNUJ... KNUJ AM 860 out of New Ulm, Minnesota once again broadcasts all 10 Gustavus regular season football games. The voice of the Golden Gusties Tom Wheeler handles the play-by-play duties for the 12th consecutive season. Wheeler is once again joined by 1984 Gustavus graduate and former Gustie football player Ken Ericson on the live call of this year's games. Fans can listen to the KNUJ broadcasts on the Internet through the Gustavus Athletics website. Gustavus provides a high definition video stream of all home games for viewing on your computer, tablet, or smart phone through GameCentral by Stretch Internet. CALLING ALL CAPTAINS... Of over 5,000 student-athletes who have played football for Gustavus in the 100-year history of the program, only 201 have earned the privilege to serve as team captain. Peter Haugen's captains this season include seniors Nathan Hajder, Hunter Johnson, and Casey Decker.

MEET THE HEAD COACHES...

Head Coach Peter Haugen is in his ninth season at the helm of the Gustavus football program. Haugen, the 2015 MIAC Co-Coach-of-the-Year, has a combined record of 41-47 and is 31-40 in the MIAC. In the past four seasons, Haugen directed the Gusties to an overall record of 24-16. A graduate of Bethel University, Haugen was the head coach at Washburn High School in Minneapolis prior to coming to Gustavus.

St. Thomas Head Coach Glen Caruso is in his 10th season leading the Tommies on the gridiron. Caruso has a combined record of 106-16 as head coach and is a three-time Liberty Mutual Division III National Coach of the Year award winner and led the Tommies to two NCAA championship games over the last six years.

THE SERIES... Saturday's game marks the 85th all-time meeting between the Gustavus and St. Thomas football programs. The Tommies lead the all-time series with a record of 47-36-2. Last season, St. Thomas posted its eighth consecutive victory over the Gusties with a 40-6 win at Hollingsworth Field.

LAST SEASON VS. THE TOMMIES... The Gusties were downed by the No. 4-ranked Tommies last season on senior day at Hollingsworth Field, falling by a score of 40-6. The Tommies outgained the Gusties 458-128 in total yards and limited the home team to two field goals. Gustavus had a significant



advantage in time of possession at 35:46-24:14, but was unable to finish drives in the endzone.

KICKING CONSISTENCY...

Senior kicker Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) has been a constant source of points from the Gustavus special teams unit. Boche leads the conference with seven field goals made. He has made at least one field goal in all but two games this season. Boche also ranks second in the MIAC with 47 points, having made 26-of-29 extra point attempts for a 90 percent completion rate. In his third season as the starting placekicker for the Gusties, Boche broke the all-time extra points made record with his 99th career PAT in the homecoming victory over Hamline on Sept. 23 to pass Hall of Famer Ryan Boutwell (1995-98). Boche holds nearly every extra point record, including career extra points made (112), most extra points made in a season (55), most extra points made in a game (9), most attempted in a career (119), most attempted in a season (58), highest career PAT percentage (94.1), and most consecutive extra points made (49).

TOUGH ON THIRD DOWN...

The Gustie defense has proven to be one of the best in the MIAC to get off the field after third down. The Gusties have limited their opponents to a 29 percent (30-104) conversion rate on third down this season, which is the fourth best season average in the conference. On the offensive side of the ball, the Gusties have converted on 47-

of-124 (38%) third downs, which is fifth best in the league.

THIS DAY IN HISTORY...

On Nov. 4, 2006, Gustavus defeated Concordia College 7-0 in Moorhead, Minn. The Gusties jumped out to a first quarter lead with a Jordan Stolp to Chad Arlt 22-yard touchdown pass and held on for the rest of the way, despite the Cobbers outgaining the Gusties 177-175.

ORTIZ RUNS INTO TOP-20...

Senior runningback Karim Ortiz (Cancun, Mexico) came into last Saturday's game versus St. Olaf with 1,261 career rushing yards and accumulated a career-high 200 rushing yards to help lead the Gusties to victory and jump into the top-20 leading rushers in Gustie football history. Ortiz now ranks 17th all-time with 1,461 career rushing yards.

SCOUTING THE GUSTIES...

Gustavus most recently snapped a three-game losing skid with a 41-13 victory over St. Olaf last Saturday at Hollingsworth Field.

After totaling just two touchdowns in the past two games, the Gustie offense got back on track, led by a 27-point second half surge against the Oles. Karim Ortiz led the ground game with a career-high 200 rushing yards, while the Gustie defense also got into the scoring column with an interception return for a touchdown. In his third game at the starting quarterback position, Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.) seemed to find his game as the leader of the Gustie offense.

MIAC Offensive Player-of-the-Week

Chad Johnson, Concordia

Glyndon, Minn./Dillworth-Glyndon-Felton

Johnson rushed for a career-high 203 yards on just 15 carries in the Cobbers' 35-12 victory over Carleton on Saturday. The performance pushed his season total past the 1,000-yard mark, while his two touchdowns on the ground advanced his own program record to 41. He is three rushing touchdowns shy of the Cobbers' single-season mark of 19 with two games left on the regular season schedule.

MIAC Defensive Player-of-the-Week

Blake Weber, St. Thomas

Prior Lake, Minn./Prior Lake

Weber led a busy St. Thomas defense that allowed just one offensive touchdown in a 58-13 victory over Bethel on Saturday. Weber was all over the field for the Tommies, logging a 13-yard sack, a seven-yard tackle for loss, a pass breakup and five tackles as St. Thomas limited the Royals to 122 yards on 58 offensive plays.

MIAC Special Teams Player-of-the-Week

Chris Fondakowski

Aurora, Ill./Maple Grove

Fondakowski was very active in the Tommies' 58-13 win over Bethel last week. The junior DB scooped up a blocked PAT kick and tossed the ball across the field to teammate Luke Swenson, who dashed 80 yards for a two-point score. Fondakowski got in on the block party as well in the second quarter, deflecting a punt and returning it 16 yards for a touchdown of his own.

Through eight games this season, Ortiz leads the Gusties on the ground with 96 carries for 442 yards and four touchdowns. In three games at the starting quarterback role, Johnson has completed 33 of 67 passes for 400 yards and two touchdowns. Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) leads the aerial attack with 34 receptions for 509 yards and five touchdowns, while Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.) has proved to be a red-zone threat with six touchdown receptions.

As the MIAC enters Week 10 of the season, Gustavus sits in fifth place in the league standings. The Gusties have the third-best offense in the league, averaging 385.3 yards per game. The passing offense is third best in the league with 258.3 yards per game, while the rushing offense is No. 4 in the conference with 127.0 yards per game.

On the defensive side of the ball, Gustavus ranks fourth in the MIAC, allowing 312.8 yards of total offense per game – 190.6 yards through the air and 122.1 yards on the ground. After tallying three sacks against the Oles, the Gusties now have 21 on the season, which is tied for the most in the conference. Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) paces the team with 54 tackles, while Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.) has five sacks and 9.5 tackles for loss.

SCOUTING THE TOMMIES...

The No. 4-ranked University of St. Thomas football team is atop of the MIAC standings with a 7-1 overall record and a perfect 6-0 mark in the league. The Tommies are coming off a 58-13 victory

over Bethel University last week. Junior quarterback Jacques Perra passed for 286 yards with three touchdown passes while five different Tommies got into the endzone.

Along with sitting at the top of the MIAC standings, the Tommies also rank No. 1 in the conference in multiple statistical categories. St. Thomas has the league's top offense with an average of 464.4 yards of total offense per game, with 1644 through the ground and 2071 through the air. The 46.5 points per game, 30 rushing touchdowns, and 189 first downs also rank first.

Perra ranks among the top quarterbacks in the MIAC, with an average of 226 passing yards per game (3rd/MIAC) and 14 passing touchdowns (4th/MIAC). Junior runningback Tucker Trettel leads the Tommie rushing game with 71.9 yards per game (5th/MIAC) and eight touchdowns (2nd/MIAC).

Defensively, St. Thomas has limited its opponents to an average of 174.9 yards of total offense per game, allowing an average of 145.6 passing yards and just 29.3 rushing yards. Senior linebacker Dylan Andrew leads the team with 27.5 tackles and nine tackles for loss, while senior defensive lineman Austin Jochum also guides the defensive unit with 10 tackles for loss and four sacks.

Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, enters his ninth year as head football coach at Gustavus Adolphus College for the 2017 season.

Last season, the Gustavus football team posted a 5-5 overall record with a MIAC mark of 3-5. The Golden Gusties started the season winning their first three games and averaged 36 points per game during the first four games. Twice the Gustie defense disallowed their opponent's offense to exceed double-digit points, defeating Westminster College 35-6 and St. Olaf College 23-3.

In the MIAC's 2016 post-season honors, first team all-conference recipients included offensive lineman Joe Theiler (Sr., Maple Grove, Minn.) and linebacker Casey Decker (Jr., Mapleton, Minn.). Second team members included running back Luke Martinez (Sr., Lenexa, Kan.), wide receiver Hunter Johnson (Jr., Cannon Falls, Minn.), offensive lineman Ryan Landherr (Sr., Prior Lake, Minn.), defensive lineman Chris Nelson (Jr., New London, Minn.), inside linebacker Jordan Kahlow (So., Le Sueur, Minn.), and kicker Brendan Boche (Jr., Lakeville, Minn.). In addition, linebackers Matt Berkner (So., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) and Leeland Lauti (Jr., Ewa Beach, Hawaii), running back Karim Ortiz (Jr., Cancun, Mexico), and defensive lineman Iker Ortiz-Hidalgo (Sr., Cancun, Mexico) earned honorable mention honors.

In eight seasons at the head of the Gustavus Adolphus football program, Haugen has compiled an overall record of 37-43 and a MIAC record of 26-38.

Haugen, who was the head football coach at Washburn High School for 15 years prior to coming to Gustavus, compiled an overall record of 111-44 during that span, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He has also served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football Conference and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early '90s. In his senior year, he earned all-conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Haugen became the 17th head coach in the 100-season history of Gustavus football in 2009. The Golden Gusties have a long and storied football tradition that includes 22 MIAC titles. The program ranks in the top-50 all-time in Division III (out of 235 institutions) with a 58.2 winning percentage (486-346-21). The Gusties will soon join an elite group of 53 NCAA Division III institutions whose football teams have won 500 games.

Along with great teams, Gustavus has also been blessed with many outstanding individual players, which includes 25 players who have received All-America honors, 13 who have received CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, and five who have received NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships.

ST. PETER, Minn. – The Gustavus football team used a balanced offensive attack and steady defensive play in its 2017 season opener, defeating Westminster College 38-0 on Saturday afternoon at Hollingsworth Field.

Four different Gusties found their way into the endzone, led by a three touchdown performance from quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.), twice completing to Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.).

“It is a good indicator, we have a lot of guys who can possess the ball and being able to spread the ball around is a good thing,” Head Coach Peter Haugen commented on the offensive balance.

The Gustavus offense just needed four plays on its first drive of the 2017 season to gain a 7-0 lead as Jamison Beulke (Jr., Montgomery, Minn.) posted a career-long 58-yard run, avoiding Blue Jay defenders towards the edge and sprinting down the sideline for the touchdown with 11:27 left in the first quarter. Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) added a 33-yard field goal at the 3:24 mark and the Gusties owned a 10-0 lead after one quarter.

With just 20 seconds remaining in the first half, Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) found Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.) in the corner of the end zone for a 16-yard touchdown pass, Panning’s first of his career as the Gusties took a 17-0 lead into halftime.

The offensive onslaught and defensive structure held throughout the second half as the Black and Gold notched their first shutout since the 2015 season, which was a 49-0 home-opening win against Lake Forest College.

Veldman completed another 16-yard touchdown pass to Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) for the Gusties sole score of the third quarter, pushing the lead to 24-0. In the fourth quarter, Karim Ortiz (Sr., Cancun, Mexico) added a two-yard touchdown run while Veldman and Panning connected for another touchdown pass near the corner of the end zone for the final score of the game as the scoreboard read 38-0.

The Gustavus defense held Westminster to just eight first downs and 153 total yards of offense through four quarters, led by a share of tackles. 19 Gusties recorded at least two tackles, led by Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.) with a career-high of nine,

including 2.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. Jordan Kahlow (Jr, Le Sueur, Minn.) also tallied two tackles for loss while Chris Nelson (Sr., New London, Minn.), Nick Jacques (So., Orono, Minn.), and Tanner Sparrow (Jr., Edina, Minn.) each contributed sacks.

“Our defense played well, it was good to get plenty of guys in there,” said Haugen. “I’m really proud of them and our defensive coaches effort. I think it was a good first game for us, there are certainly some things we’re going to have to work through, but all in all, we had good effort with a lot of different guys playing. The game plan was solid and is something we can build on.”

Beulke led Gustavus with 91 rushing yards, 91 passing yards, as well as 182 all-purpose yards on the day. Veldman finished the game with 17 completed passes on 31 attempts for 290 yards.

Next weekend, the Gusties travel to River Falls, Wis. for another non-conference game against the University of Wisconsin-River Falls. Last season, Gustavus hosted the Falcons and came away with a 24-21 victory during the home opener. Kickoff is set for 7 p.m. on Saturday at Ramer Field.

“We’re going to have to get better, UW-River Falls is a good football team and we were fortunate enough to win against them a year ago, but this year is a whole new story,” Haugen concluded.

RIVER FALLS, Wis. – The Gustavus football team was defeated 20-12 at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls on Saturday evening, as the Gusties wrapped up their non-conference action with a 1-1 overall record.

After a strong offensive output in the season opener a week ago, the Gustie offensive attack was hindered, as a ground-heavy Falcon offense put up 166 rush yards and limited Gustavus to just 29. Despite recording the most passing yards in a game since 2015 with 334, the Gusties were only able to come away with one touchdown and two field goals.

UW-River Falls relied on its rushing attack as they claimed a 14-3 lead in the first half. The Falcons led the Gusties with in rushing yards, 67-26, and ate up the clock, converting five of nine third down attempts. On their first opportunity of the game, UWRF used a 10-play, five minute drive. Michael Gibbons scored a 23-yard rushing touchdown to give UW-River Falls the first lead of the game with 7:18 remaining, where the score stood after the first quarter.

Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) was successful on a 32-yard field goal attempt that was the Gusties only score of the first half, as Gustavus trailed UW-River Falls 7-3 with 14:56 remaining in the second quarter. The Gusties and Falcons each traded a few possessions prior to UW-River Falls tacking on another touchdown, late in the first half. With just 57 seconds left in the half, Tim McCarthy hauled in an 11-yard touchdown pass to give the home team a 14-3 lead heading into the intermission.

Boche opened the scoring in the second half, making it a one-score game and cutting the UW-River Falls lead to eight with his second field goal of the game, a 38-yard field goal to complete a 15 play, 70-yard drive at the 6:19 minute mark of the third quarter.

The Gustie field goal was answered by the Falcons, keeping the ground-game steady with another rushing touchdown from Diggins to take a 20-6 lead near the end of the third quarter.

In the back-end of the fourth quarter, the Gustavus defense led an

effort to make a late push. With 9:16 left, the Gusties forced the first turnover of the game as the Black and Gold forced a UWRF fumble. However, Gustavus was unable to convert the turnover into points. In the next defensive drive, Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) recorded his first career interception and brought it back 37 yards as the Gusties had 4:20 remaining for a comeback. On the ensuing drive, the Gusties scored their sole touchdown of the game as Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) chucked a hail mary-like career-long 42-yard pass to Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.), who brought in a great catch for his second score of the season. It wasn't enough, as UWRF ran down the clock to secure the 20-12 victory.

Berkner, Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.), and Dutch Claybaugh (Jr., Kaneohe, Hawaii) combined to lead the defensive effort, tallying eight tackles each.

Veldman completed 29 passes on 47 attempts, totaling a career-best 334 passing yards. Kirk led the receiving core with the sole touchdown and a career-high six receptions for 114 yards. Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.) also brought in a career-high 11 receptions for 84 yards.

Gustavus heads into Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference play next Saturday, heading to Minneapolis, Minn. to take on Augsburg College.

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn. – The Gustavus football team claimed a 42-37 victory over Augsburg University in its Minnesota Collegiate Athletic Conference opener on Saturday afternoon at Edor Nelson Field.

Guided by a strong start and offensive onslaught, the Gusties (2-1, 1-0 MIAC) totaled 532 yards of offense to take down the Auggies (2-1, 0-1 MIAC).

Gustavus opened the game recording four scores, led by three touchdown passes from quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) while the Gustie defense limited the Auggies to just one score, taking a 28-7 lead into the intermission.

On their second offensive drive of the game, the Gusties completed the sole touchdown of the first quarter, an eight-yard touchdown pass from Veldman to Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.), his third of the season.

The Black and Gold outscored Augsburg 21-7 in the second quarter, led by two more touchdown passes from Veldman along with a three-yard rushing touchdown from Jamison Beulke (So., Montgomery, Minn.). Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) brought in an eleven-yard pass for his third touchdown of the season, followed by Beulke's score to increase the lead to 21-0. After the Auggies' completed a 27-yard pass for their only score of the first half, Cam Hufendick (Sr., Minneapolis, Minn.) completed his first career touchdown with a four-yard reception as Gustavus took a 21-point lead into halftime.

"We were playing very efficiently on both sides of the ball," Head Coach Peter Haugen spoke of the Gusties' play in the first half. "Our defense also played very well in the first half. It was definitely a story of two halves, but at the same time we made some key conversions offensively to keep drives alive in the second half."

Triggered by a forced fumble, Augsburg stole the momentum out of the gate in the second half, compiling 17 points to cut the Gustie lead to 28-24 heading into the final frame. However, Gustavus maintained its lead as they matched Augsburg's score total. Each team scored twice in the fourth quarter, another receiving touchdown from Panning and rushing score from Beulke for the

Gusties. Down by one score, Augsburg's last chance to take the lead was taken away with an interception from Drew Fredericksen (Sr., Forsyth, Ill.), solidifying the victory.

Veldman finished with a career-best game, totaling the most passing yards by a Gustie quarterback since 2014, completing 35 passes for 430 yards and four touchdowns. Beulke also led the Gustavus offense with 284 all-purpose yards, registering career-high rushing and receiving totals. Beulke led the rushing game with 99 yards on 21 carries and carried the receiving core with 14 catches for 185 yards.

"He played well," Haugen spoke of Veldman's performance. "He made some really big throws and was extending plays with his arm. Beulke was the big story of the day, though."

Defensively, the Gusties were led once again by linebacker Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.), who totaled nine tackles, including 2.5 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, and one pass breakup. In addition, 10 other Gusties contributed tackles for loss. As a team, Gustavus totaled five sacks and 12 tackles for loss.

"There is so much to learn this week that will help us down the road. First of all, winning a close game in the end is just an invaluable experience. Making a huge play at the end of the game to win it, with the interception, is huge. Wins are hard to come by, so we are thankful to build on that," Haugen concluded.

ST. PETER, Minn. – The Gustavus football team totaled 566 yards of total offense and rolled to a convincing 51-7 homecoming victory over Hamline University on Saturday afternoon at Hollingsworth Field.

After Hamline snapped the Gusties' 10-game winning streak with a 42-40 win on its home turf a season ago, Gustavus came back with its highest offensive output since the 2015 season while totaling over 400 passing yards for the second game in a row.

Quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) finished with 392 passing yards, completing 26 passes on 42 attempts to go with his second consecutive four-touchdown performance. The receiving trio of Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.), Brayton Finch (So., Mount Morris, Ill.), and Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) combined for 340 receiving yards off 21 receptions.

The Black and Gold scored on its opening drive as Kirk converted a double reverse, taking a pitch from Nathan Schroeppfer (Fy., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) for the 37-yard score. Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) added a 24-yard field goal to give the Gusties a 10-0 lead after the first frame.

Hamline opened the second quarter with its sole score of the game prior to the Gustavus offense answering on the next drive and opening up the flood gates. Veldman and the Gustie receiving core converted three touchdown passes to take a 31-7 lead into the intermission.

Veldman hit Finch for a career-long 81-yard touchdown pass, followed by a Johnson 11-yard touchdown, followed by Kirk's second score of the game and his fourth receiving touchdown of

the season. With the Johnson score, Gustie kicker Brendan Boche tallied his 99th career extra point made to pass Ryan Boutwell (1995-98) as the all-time extra points made leader.

Gustavus added three more scores in the second half while the defense kept the Piper offense at bay. Rafael Soriano-Campos (So., Guadalajara, Mexico) scored his first career touchdown from two yards out before Johnson picked up second touchdown reception of the game. The Gusties closed out their scoring in the fourth quarter as Gavyn Walsh (Fy., Andover, Minn.) connected with Greg Knaack (Jr., Burnsville, Minn.) for a 17-yard touchdown pass, their first career touchdowns.

Defensively, the Gusties limited the Pipers to under 200 yards and total offense and totaled 13 tackles for loss and five sacks. Jake Boykin (So., Las Cruces, N.M.) led the team with seven tackles. Ben Rengel (Jr., Sartell, Minn.) picked up two tackles for loss and a sack, while Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.) also tallied two tackles for loss, one sack, and one pass breakup.

MOORHEAD, Minn. – Turnovers proved to be the difference in a 27-17 loss for the Gustavus football team at No. 16 Concordia-Moorhead on Saturday. The Gusties led 14-10 at halftime, but the Cobbers were able to turn an interception and a fumble recovery into 14 points, while holding the visitors to a field goal in the final 30 minutes to secure the victory. Gustavus drops to 3-2 overall and 2-1 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, while Concordia remains unbeaten at 4-0 overall and 2-0 in the league.

Concordia outgained the Gusties 305-226 in yards from scrimmage, relying heavily on its ground game for 274 rushing yards. Gustavus posted a season-low 183 passing yards along with 43 rushing yards.

"Our guys played hard, and it was a tough game played on both sides of the field," Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "It all came down to a few plays and execution, but I'm proud of the way our guys battled today."

On the first play of the game, the Gusties were supplied a jolt of momentum as Austin Fest (Fy., West Des Moines, Iowa) forced a fumble on the opening kickoff return, which was recovered by Matthew Montplaisir (So., Buffalo, Minn.). The Gustavus offense took the field on the Cobber 27-yard line and the initial drive sputtered out and was forced to punt, but a personal foul gave the Black and Gold a fresh set of downs. Two plays later Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) found Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.) for a 26-yard touchdown – their third scoring connection of the season.

Both teams' next possession ended with a punt, but the Cobbers followed with an eight-play scoring drive, finishing on a 12-yard touchdown run and the score read 7-7 with 5:13 left in the first quarter. Gustavus took little time to answer as it drove 84 yards in eight plays, capped by a 36-yard touchdown pass from Veldman to Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.) and the Gusties led 14-7 with 1:59 remaining in the opening frame.

Each team ensued with three punts apiece before Concordia was able to generate an offensive drive late in the half. The Cobbers went 38 yards on nine plays, resulting in a 29-yard field goal to make the score 14-10, which stood at halftime.

The two squads traded short possessions to start the second half and Gustavus started its second drive of the third quarter from its own 25. Veldman nearly completed a 40-yard strike to Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.), but the pass fell incomplete. The following play, Veldman was intercepted and the Cobbers took it to the endzone for a 32-yard return and a 17-14 lead with 8:31 on the clock. Two possessions later, first-year quarterback Gavyn Walsh

(Fy., Andover, Minn.) entered the game for an injured Veldman and guided the Gusties into Cobber territory, setting up a 44-yard field goal by Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) to tie the game 17-17 early in the fourth quarter.

Concordia answered on the next drive, going 30 yards on six plays, capped by a 32-yard field goal to regain the lead 20-17 with 10:12 remaining in the game. The back-breaker for the Gusties came next as they fumbled the kickoff return, which was recovered by the Cobbers at the 23-yard line. Four plays later, the home team found the endzone on a four-yard rush and took a 27-17 advantage with 8:39 to play.

The Gusties wouldn't go quietly, though, as Drew Fredericksen (Sr., Forsyth, Ill.) returned the ensuing kickoff 79 yards down to the Cobber 15-yard line, but a quick three-and-out followed by a missed 25-yard field goal kept the score at a 10-point difference. Gustavus forced a Concordia punt on the next drive, but was unable to generate any more offense and time ran out on a potential comeback bid.

Veldman finished the game 16-of-31 for 163 yards with two touchdowns and an interception in just over two quarters of play. Walsh came in and completed 5-of-8 passes for 20 yards. Karim Ortiz (Sr., Cancun, Mexico) was the leading rusher with 55 yards on 19 carries, while Johnson was the top receiving target by hauling in seven catches for 54 yards and a score. Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) paced the defense with a career-high 14 total tackles. The Gustie defense was stout on third down, limiting the Cobbers to one first down in 10 attempts.

ST. PETER, Minn. – The Gustavus football team dropped a 24-3 during a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference matchup against Bethel University Saturday afternoon at Hollingsworth Field.

The Gusties, now 3-3 overall and 2-2 during conference play, were without starting quarterback Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) and struggled to find a consistent output with a new-look offense.

Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.) stepped into the quarterback role, completing 11 passes for 105 yards. Jamison Beulke (Jr., Montgomery, Minn.) led the rushing unit with 60 yards on 16 carries.

“Clearly, our execution wasn’t there,” said Head Coach Peter Haugen. “There were too many negative plays on first down, I think that hurt us. The first half was a disappointment.”

Near the end of the first quarter, the Royals tallied the first score of the game during their second drive. Hayden Foote carried in a fourth and goal opportunity from the one-yard line to give Bethel a 7-0 lead.

The following drive would stand as the sole scoring drive of the game for Gustavus. Relying on the ground attack, the Gusties drove down the field with a 16-play, 69-yard drive, capped off by a 29-yard field goal from Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.).

On the ensuing kickoff, Joel Koenecke returned a Boche kickoff 92 yards for a Royal touchdown to give Bethel a 14-3 lead. Following the kick-return score, the road team maintained momentum, adding another score to hold a 21-3 at the halfway point. The kick return score was the first the Gusties have allowed since Augsburg brought one back in 2012.

Gustavus was unable to put together any scoring drives in the second half, despite the Black and Gold defense limiting Bethel to a

field goal in the 24-3 final.

“The second half, I thought we really stiffened up and played really hard. We needed this to be a 10-6 game, and I think we had our shot at that. Both offenses were pretty mundane, to be honest. I was happy with the way the guys responded in the second half. We just need to keep building off that.”

In all, Gustavus and Bethel each tallied 12 first downs, while the Royals totaled 253 yards of total offense compared to 202 from the Gusties.

Dutch Claybaugh (Jr., Kaneohe, Hawaii) and Nathan Hajder (Sr., Rogers, Minn.) led the Gustavus defensive effort with six tackles each.

Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.) totaled six punts for a career-best 257 yards, averaging 42.8 yards per punt while also tallying a season-long 57-yard punt.

“We did see some things that were encouraging and hopefully we can get rolling down that way. For us, we have to play a complete game. It is the little mistakes that hurt us, we just have to find a way to be a little more consistent,” Haugen concluded.

COLLEGEVILLE, Minn. – The Gustavus football team couldn't overcome a 34-point first half deficit during a 41-17 loss against the No. 7/8-ranked Saint John's University Johnnies Saturday afternoon at Clemens Stadium.

The loss drops the Gusties to 3-4 overall and 2-3 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, while the Johnnies improve to 7-1 overall and 5-1 in the league.

Saint John's did all of its damage in the first half, scoring 21 points in the first quarter and 20 in the second, while holding the Gusties to one touchdown to own a 41-7 lead at the halfway mark. The Johnnies used a strong aerial attack as each of their scores were passing touchdowns, totaling 365 passing yards and 523 yards of total offense.

Karim Ortiz (Sr., Cancun, Mexico) scored the sole Gustie touchdown of the first half, rushing in from one-yard out for his second score of the season.

In the second half, the Black and Gold defense held strong while totaling two scores in the final frame. Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.) picked up a 34-yard field goal, followed by another one-yard touchdown run Ortiz.

Ortiz finished the game with 83 rushing yards on 22 attempts to go along with his two touchdowns. In his second game in the starting quarterback role, Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.) passed for 145 yards while rushing for 21.

Drew Fredericksen (Sr., Forsyth, Ill.) and Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the defensive effort with seven tackles each. Fredericksen's seven tackles is a career-high while he added a pass breakup. Berkner also recorded a sack and one tackle for loss.

ST. PETER, Minn. – The Gustavus football team snapped a three-game losing skid with a 41-13 victory over St. Olaf College Saturday afternoon at Hollingsworth Field.

After totaling just two touchdowns in the past two games, the Gustie offense got back on track, led by a 27-point second half surge against the Oles. Karim Ortiz (Sr., Cancun, Mexico) led the ground game with a career-high 200 rushing yards, while the Gustie defense also got into the scoring column with an interception return for a touchdown. In his third game at the starting quarterback position, Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.) seemed to find his game as the leader of the Gustie offense.

Gustavus claimed a 14-7 lead through two quarters of play. Johnson opened the scoring during the home team's second drive of the game, finishing off a 15-yard score with an extension towards the pylon. The Oles answered with a score of their own midway through the second quarter to even the game.

Linebacker Avery Bachman (So., St. Peter, Minn.) negated any thoughts of the two teams heading into the intermission tied at 7-7, forcing a St. Olaf fumble to give the Gusties great field position with 47 seconds remaining in the half. Gustavus then completed a five-play, 28-yard scoring drive. Johnson floated a pass to the corner of the end zone to Brice Panning (So., Hamburg, Minn.) for the 14-yard touchdown pass, Panning's team-leading sixth of the season to give Gustavus the 14-7 lead at the half.

The Oles opened the scoring in the second half with their final score of the game, missing the point after try to cut the Gustie lead to 14-13. On the ensuing drive, Johnson ran in his second touchdown

of the game from five yards out to push the lead to 21-13.

In the final quarter, Gustavus put together two consecutive scoring drives, followed by a pick-six to close out the visitors. Johnson completed his second passing TD of the game to Josh Kirk (So., Garvin, Minn.) to open the fourth-quarter outpour, topped by a career-high 69-yard run from Ortiz. The final score of the game was a 35-yard interception return from Jordan Kahlow (Jr., Le Sueur, Minn.), his second pick-six of his career.

Johnson completed 12-24 passes for 150 yards, while Kirk led the receiving core with five catches for 70 yards.

Jake Boykin (So., Las Cruces, N.M.) tallied a team-high eight tackles, while Kevin Krohn (Sr., Richfield, Minn.) gathered two sacks and three tackles for loss. Kahlow and Brady Miller (Jr., Delano, Minn.) recorded interceptions.
