2017-18 GUSTAVUS WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

SETTING THE SCENE

The No. 12-ranked Gustavus women's basketball team is back home tonight for a non-conference game against UW-River Falls, starting at 7 p.m. The Gusties enter the contest with a 3-0 record, while the Falcons are 3-1.

THE SERIES

Saturday's game marks the 76th meeting between Gustavus and St. Olaf with the Gusties holding a 51-24 lead in the all-time series. The two teams last faced each other on Feb. 8 as the Gusties claimed a convincing 81-47 win in Northfield, Minn. Kelsey Carpenter scored a career-high 31 points with a record-tying eight three pointers. The eight three-point field goals tied Melissa Young's record set in 1992.

The Gusties saw good point production from their reserves as they outscored the Oles 46-8 in bench points. Nine Gusties found their way into the scoring column with Carpenter, Mikayla Miller and Miranda Rice each posting double-digit point performances. Miller and Rice both tallied 10 points. Another record-setting performance came from Miller as she picked up two steals to pass Jess Vadnais (2004-08) on the program's all-time steals list. Miller moved to No. 1 with 224 career steals in her third season as a Gustie.

IN THE POLLS

D3hoops.com ranked Gustavus No. 16 in its preseason Top 25 poll and after starting the season 3-0 the Gusties moved up four spots to No. 12 in the Nov. 26 poll. MIAC foe St. Thomas is one spot ahead of the Gusties at No. 11, while Tufts holds on to the No. 1 ranking.

ABOUT THE OLES

St. Olaf is off to a tough start to its 2017-18 campaign with just two wins in seven games. The Oles most recently lost 81-55 to UW-Stout on Tuesday. Their most recent victory was a 58-50 decision over Crown College last Saturday. Through seven games Makenna Ash is the team's leading scorer with 12.9 points per game and shooting 47.4 per-

cent from the field. Ash also leads the team on the board with 9.0 rebounds per game. Ella Skrien is next in line on the offensive side of the floor with 8.4 points per game.

LAST TIME OUT

After a slow start to Thursday's non-conference women's basketball game, Gustavus used a big third quarter, outscoring UW-River Falls 26-13, en route to a decisive 71-50 victory at Gus Young Court.

Miranda Rice (Sr., Forest Lake, Minn.) led the Gustavus offense for the third time this season, posting 28 points on 10-of-15 shooting from the floor, including 8-of-11 free throws and eight rebounds. Mikayla Miller (Sr., Goodhue, Minn.) added 13 points, six rebounds, and five assists, while Taylor Anderson (Jr., Rogers, Minn.) contributed 10 points and five boards.

Both teams were sluggish out of the gate with a 12-9 UW-River Falls lead after the first quarter. Gustavus responded with eight straight points and held the lead the rest of the game. The Gusties took a 27-24 advantage into the locker room at halftime.

Three minutes into the second half Gustavus scored 13 unanswered points to gain a 47-27 lead and cruised the rest of the way for the convincing win. UW-River Falls committed 23 turnovers, which Gustavus turned into 26 points. The Gusties also had 12 second chance points and out-rebounded the Falcons 36-22, 16 of which on the offensive glass. Gustavus went to the charity stripe 35 times and made 26 of those shots.

15-YEAR ANNIVERSARY

2002-03 MIAC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM

The Gustavus women's basketball team claimed a share of its first-ever conference championship during the 2002-03 season. Gustavus tied with Carleton and Saint Benedict atop the MIAC with identical 20-2 records against conference foes. The Gusties finished the regular season with a thrilling 63-62 win at Carleton in front of 1,250 fans. The Black and Gold led by as much as 17 points in the second half and fended off a strong comeback effort by the Knights to secure the one-point win.

The Gusties reached the championship game of the MIAC Tournament and in a revenge game were defeated by Carleton. Gustavus then received an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament. In the first NCAA playoff game in the program's history, Gustavus defeated Loras 67-59 at home and then fell 68-54 in the second round to Pacific Lutheran on the road.

Gustavus won 13 consecutive games to begin the season and set the school record for wins and conference wins in a season. Head Coach Mickey Haller became the fastest coach in the program's history to record her 50th career victory midway through the season.

Senior Kelly Etzel and junior Angie Peterson were named to the MIAC All-Conference Team. Junior Kate Sandvig was named to the MIAC All-Defensive Team while Coach Haller was named Co-MIAC Coach of the Year. Peterson and Etzel were also named to the D3hoops.com All-West Region Team. Peterson was named honorable mention All-America by WBCA and Kodak. Sandvig was named to the Verizon Academic District V Third Team.

HEAD COACH LAURIE KELLY



Laurie Kelly is in her sixth season as the head coach of the Gustavus women's basketball team in 2017-18. Kelly, a 1993 graduate of the University of St. Thomas with a degree in speech communications, came to Gustavus from Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff, where she directed the Division I Lumberjacks for nine seasons.

In 2016-17, Kelly led Gustavus to one of the best seasons in program history, appearing in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2008. The Gusties tied a program record 25 wins and a .960 win percentage, finishing 25-3 overall. Following Kelly's second season at Gustavus in 2012-13, the Gusties achieved a significant milestone when the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced its Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll following the year. Making their 15th appearance on the NCAA Division III honor roll, the Gusties were recognized as the team with the top cumulative grade point average in country at a 3.600 – a first in the program's history.

A Rochester, Minnesota native, Kelly made a quick ascent through the Division II and I coaching ranks after a record setting Division III playing career at the University of St. Thomas in the early '90s. In nine years at Northern Arizona, she compiled the most wins in the program's history (117), while also directing the team to its first-ever Big Sky Conference tournament title and NCAA tournament bid in the 2005-06 season. During Kelly's tenure, the Lumberjacks advanced to the Big Sky tournament six times with two appearances in the championship game (2006, 2007), and her teams registered two of the three 20-win seasons in the program's history.

In addition to quality on the floor, her squads were also strong in the classroom, with four players earning CoSIDA Academic All-District honors including one Academic All-American. The Lumberjacks were recognized in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Top 25 Academic Honor Roll six times, with two Top Ten national rankings.

Prior to her position at Northern Arizona, Kelly coached at Binghamton University in New York and built the Bearcats into one of the top Division II programs in the country before helping the

institution transition to a Division I program in 2001-02. In that first year of Division I competition, Kelly directed the team to a 19-9 record and a second-place finish in the America East Conference. During her five years at Binghamton, Kelly compiled a record of 94-22, including a mark of 75-13 in the program's final three years at the Division II level, and her squads won New England Collegiate Conference (NECC) titles in 1999 and 2000 and Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference (ECAC) titles in 2000 and 2001. She was named ECAC Coach of the Year in 2000 and New York State Coach of the Year in 2002. Kelly started her collegiate coaching career as the graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University, Mankato from 1996 to 1998. While she was at Minnesota State, Mankato she earned a master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in sports administration.

Before her success in the coaching ranks, Laurie Trow Kelly was a standout player at the University of St. Thomas from 1989 to 1993 and is recognized by many as one of the greatest players in NCAA Division III history. A gifted athlete, the 6-1 Kelly scored 2,607 points and pulled down 1,204 rebounds in four years, earning Kodak All-America honors three consecutive seasons. In her senior season (1992-93), Kelly was voted National Player of the Year by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association after averaging more than 26 points per game. She set 22 conference and 24 school records, was conference MVP three times and was also named Midwest Sports Channel NCAA Division III Women's Athlete of the Year. In January of 2006, Kelly was one of five players selected to the NCAA Division III 25th Anniversary Team.

Laurie Kelly is the ninth head coach in the history of the Gustavus women's basketball program. In addition to her coaching duties, Kelly serves as the coordinator of the Gustavus Health Promotion program (GHP). The Gustavus Health Promotion program offers employees at Gustavus a variety of educational opportunities, assessment tools, and physical activity experiences so that they can achieve and maintain a healthy lifestyle.

Kelly lives in St. Peter with and her husband, Matt, and their two daughters, Morgan and Madison.
