**THE SERIES:** Saturday's game marks the 41st all-time meeting between the Gustavus and Bethel football programs. The Royals lead the series 23-17 and have won the past nine meetings. In last season's matchup at Hollingsworth Field, Bethel scored the first touchdown and never trailed en route to a 24-3 victory.

**GUSTIES IN 102nd SEASON:** The Gustavus football team continues its 102nd season Saturday at Royal Stadium. Over the previous 101 seasons, the Gusties have compiled an overall record of 496-356-21, including a record of 232-131-8 in Saint Peter. With 22 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) championships, Gustavus has claimed the second-most league titles in the 99-year history of the conference. Only Saint John's (32) has claimed more MIAC championships.

**LAST WEEK:** In the first home night game since 1988, the Gustavus football team dropped a 45-13 decision to No. 9 Saint John's last Saturday night at Saint Peter High School's Floyd B. Johnson Memorial Field. The Gusties dropped to 1-2 overall and 0-1 in the MIAC, while the Johnnies moved to 2-0 overall and 1-0 in the league. The game was moved back to 7 p.m. from 1 p.m. due to afternoon heat and humidity levels that would have warranted significant delays. The Johnnies carried a 24-13 lead into halftime and outscored the home team 21-0 in the second half. Saint John's outgained the Black and Gold 409-313. Gustavus did well on third down, converting on 10-of-18 opportunities. Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) completed 19-of-34 passes for 255 yards, two touchdowns, and an interception. Josh Kirk (Jr., Garvin, Minn.) hauled in a game-high eight receptions for 63 yards and a score, while Brice Panning (Jr., Hamburg, Minn.) made four catches for 140 yards. David Peal (Fy., Worcester, Mass.) led a pedestrian rushing attack with six carries for 20 yards. For the third consecutive game, Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the defense with 10 tackles.

**SCOUTING THE GUSTIES**

Gustavus enters Saturday's game 1-2 overall and 0-1 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference after losing 45-13 to Saint John's last Saturday under the lights of Saint Peter High School's Floyd B. Johnson Memorial Field.

A 15-yard throw-back pass from Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) to Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, Ill.) midway through the second quarter brought the Gustie deficit to 17-13, but the Johnnies were able to add another touchdown with 2:24 remaining in the half and held the home team scoreless the rest of the way. A 92-yard blocked field goal return for a touchdown put the game out of reach early in the fourth.

After three games this season, Gustavus leads the league on third down having converted on 22-of-45 chances. The Gusties also lead the conference with 15 kick returns for 301 yards for an average of 20.1 yards. Their 293 total tackles are most in the MIAC as well.

Behind center, Veldman has completed 59-of-110 passes for 713 yards, all marks that rank second in the MIAC. Veldman also has thrown for seven touchdowns and three interceptions. The passing game averages 240 yards per game, led on the receiving end by Brice Panning (Jr., Hamburg, Minn.) with 15 catches for 313 yards. Panning ranks second in the MIAC in total receiving yards, yards per game (104.3), and yards per catch (20.9). The rushing attack is paced by Finch with 40 carries for 149 yards and a touchdown. Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) leads the defense with 33 tackles.

**SCOUTING THE ROYALS**

After enjoying its bye last week, Bethel enters its conference opening matchup 2-0. The Royals started the season with a 41-29 victory at Simpson followed by a 32-27 win over UW-River Falls on Sept. 8. Against the Falcons, Bethel outgained the opposition 468-324 with a balanced offensive attack (253 passing, 215 rushing). The Royals were able to control the clock, holding possession for 37:59. A 20-point first quarter gave the Royals a cushion and they were able to hold off a fourth quarter comeback.

Through two games, Bethel has been efficient in the red zone, scoring nine times in 10 opportunities, which is the best percentage in the MIAC. The Royals also lead the conference in time of possession, averaging 36:52 per game. Their offense averages 36.5 points and 409.0 yards per game, both marks that rank third in the league.

The ground game is led by Sam Gibas, who has 272 yards and five touchdowns on 47 carries. His 136.0 yards per game leads the conference. Jaren Roste has led a two-quarterback system, completing 19-of-25 passes for 270 yards, three touchdowns, and one interception. Jake Marsh has also spent time under center, going 9-for-20 for 98 yards, a touchdown, and two interceptions. Joel Koenecke is the leading receiver with eight catches for 135 yards and a touchdown. On defense, Dawson Brown lead the MIAC with 13.0 tackles per game. He also has two interceptions and 1.5 tackles for loss.

**FOLLOW THE GUSTIES ON KNUJ**

KNUJ AM 860 out of New Ulm, Minn. once again broadcasts all 10 Gustavus regular season games this year. The voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handles the play-by-play duties for the 13th consecutive season. Wheeler is once again joined by 1984 Gustavus graduate and former Gustie football player Ken Ericson on the live call of this year's games.

**GUSTIES AROUND THE GLOBE**

The 2018 Gustavus football team features a total of 100 players from 13 different states and, for the seventh-straight year, countries outside of the United States.

Of those 100 players, 73 claim Minnesota as their native state. Five players call Florida home, four from California, three from Texas, two from Hawaii, two from New Mexico, two from Iowa, and one player each from Massachusetts, Louisiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Colorado, and Alaska represent the Stars and Stripes. For the first time in Head Coach Peter Haugen's tenure, three countries outside the United States are represented in Mexico, Germany, and Ghana.

**HAUGEN FACES ALMA MATER**

Gustavus Head Coach Peter Haugen, a 1991 graduate of Bethel College, is facing his alma mater today for the 10th time in his coaching career at Gustavus. Not only is Haugen facing his former team, but he is also facing his former coach in Steve Johnson. Haugen played tight end for the Royals from 1987-90 and was on Johnson's first team in 1989 when the Royals went 2-6-1.

**SATURDAY NIGHT LIGHTS**

For the first time since Sept. 10, 1988, Gustavus hosted a home night game last Saturday against Saint John's at Saint Peter High School's Floyd B. Johnson Memorial Field. Gustavus and Saint Peter High School also rekindled a field-sharing use that dates back 89 years. Gustavus had the first lighted football field in Minnesota (and perhaps the Midwest) and played the first night game in 1929. That same year, Saint Peter High School used the field and gained the honor of playing the first night high school game in Minnesota.

**MAGIC No. 24**

Dating back to the 2015 season, Gustavus is 11-1 when scoring at least 24 points. Under Head Coach Peter Haugen, the Gusties are 38-10 when putting up 24 points dating back to his first season in 2009.

**BIG PLAY PANNING**

Brice Panning has proven himself to be the big-play target this season with four catches of over 40 yards. Last week against Saint John's, Panning hauled in a 50-yard catch on third down and later in the game he was on the receiving end of a 45-yard broken play, again on third down.

## GUSTAVUS HEAD COACH PETER HAUGEN



### 10th season as Gustavus Head Coach

Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, is in his 10th year as head football coach at Gustavus Adolphus College for the 2018 season.

Last season, the Gustavus football team posted a 5-5 overall record with a MIAC mark of 4-4. The Golden Gusties started the season winning three of their first four games and averaged 36 points per game during that time. The Gusties bookend the 2017 campaign with shutout performances, beating Westminster 38-0 to start the year and then topping Carleton 52-0 to end the season.

In the MIAC's 2017 postseason honors, defensive end/punter Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.) earned first team all-conference honors. Second team members included Brayton Finch (So., Mount Morris, Ill.), Kevin Krohn (Sr., Richfield, Minn.), Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.), and Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.). In addition, Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.), Karim Ortiz (Sr., Cancun, Mexico), and Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) earned honorable mention honors.

In nine seasons at the head of the Gustavus Adolphus football program, Haugen has compiled an overall record of 42-48 and a MIAC record of 30-42.

Haugen, who was the head football coach at Washburn High School for 15 years prior to coming to Gustavus, compiled an overall record of 111-44 during that span, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and

meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He has also served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football Conference and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early '90s. In his senior year, he earned all-conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Haugen became the 17th head coach in the 101-season history of Gustavus football in 2009. The Golden Gusties have a long and storied football tradition that includes 22 MIAC titles. The program ranks in the top-50 all-time in Division III (out of 246 institutions) with a 58.0 winning percentage (496-356-21). The Gusties will soon join an elite group of 57 NCAA Division III institutions whose football teams have won 500 games.

Along with great teams, Gustavus has also been blessed with many outstanding individual players, which includes 31 players who have received All-America honors, 16 who have received CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, and five who have received NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships.

## 2018 GUSTAVUS ASSISTANT COACHES

### **CHARLIE COSGROVE**

#### **CO-OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR, OFFENSIVE LINE**

Charlie Cosgrove is in his 10th season on the Gustavus football coaching staff, serving as the team's co-offensive coordinator and offensive line coach for the seventh straight year. Prior to coming to Gustavus, Cosgrove served as a graduate assistant at St. Cloud State University for two years.

A 2005 graduate of St. Cloud State with a degree in mass communications, Cosgrove was a standout defensive end for the Huskie football squad, earning All-Conference honors three times and being named to the National Football Coaches Association All-America Team in 2005. He was also named the North Central Conference Defensive Lineman of the Year his senior season. In St. Cloud State football history, Cosgrove graduated ranked first in tackles for loss (47.5) and quarterback hurries (28), and second in sacks (23.5) and forced fumbles (7).

### **CARLIN SHOEMAKER**

#### **CO-OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR, QUARTERBACKS**

Carlin Shoemaker returns for his seventh season on the Gustavus Adolphus football coaching staff as the co-offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach.

A 2003 graduate of Bethel High School in Spanaway, Washington, Shoemaker brings an extensive offensive background to the Gustavus coaching staff. Shoemaker completed his undergraduate studies in the spring of 2007, earning a degree in psychology from Kenyon College. While at Kenyon, Shoemaker went on to have one of the best receiving careers in the history of Lords football. A two-time captain in 2006 and 2007, Carlin made a total of 239 catches for 3,000 yards with 18 receiving touchdowns over his four-year career. His 239 receptions rank second all-time at Kenyon, while his total yards mark ranks third. To go along with his offensive production, he is also the program's top kick returner, recording 93 returns for 1,873 yards. A three-time All North Coast Athletic Conference (NCAC) performer in 2004, 2006, and 2007, Carlin concluded his career by being named the team's MVP his senior season.

Following his playing career at Kenyon, Shoemaker served as a graduate assistant coach at St. Cloud State University from 2008 to 2010. While on staff at St. Cloud State, he served as the wide receivers coach. Shoemaker made his way into the MIAC with Carleton College in 2010 where he served as the quarterbacks coach. After a year in Northfield and prior to taking the job at Gustavus, he took a position as the co-offensive coordinator at his alma mater, Kenyon, for the 2011 season.

Carlin currently resides in St. Peter with his wife, Courtney.

### **LUCAS KLEINSCHRODT**

#### **DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR, DEFENSIVE BACKS**

Lucas Kleinschrodt begins his third season on staff for the Gustavus Adolphus football team in 2018, and second season as the defensive coordinator.

A native of Alden, Minnesota, Kleinschrodt graduated from Alden-Conger High School in 2010. From there, Lucas attended Gustavus where he graduated in 2013 with an undergraduate degree in Health Fitness.

Kleinschrodt was a four-year letterwinner for the Gusties as a linebacker. He recorded 146 tackles in 38 career games at Gustavus, rank-

ing fifth on his team with a career-high 42 tackles his senior season in 2013. He finished his career with three interceptions, two fumble recoveries, four pass break-ups and four tackles for loss.

Kleinschrodt currently lives in St. Peter with his wife, Ali.

### **CHRISTIAN WHITE**

#### **KICKERS**

Christian White is in his 10th year as a coach under head coach Peter Haugen. White, who has assisted the Gustavus football program off and on over the past decade, specifically works with the team's kickers and punters.

A native of Northfield, Minn., White was a four-year member of the Gustavus football team from 1997-2000. A First-Team All-Conference placekicker in 1999, Christian majored in management and earned his degree in 2001 from Gustavus. Following his Gustavus career, White began flight school in Orlando, Fla. in June of 2001. 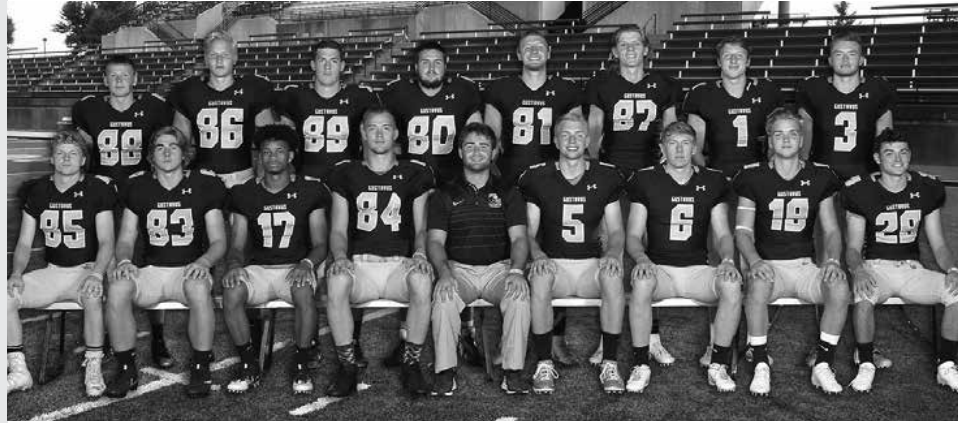

WEEK 1 • NEW ULM, MINN. • GUSTAVUS 32, MARTIN LUTHER 20

It took some time for the Gustavus football team to find its footing Saturday in the season opener at Martin Luther College, but after trailing by two at halftime the Gusties made the necessary adjustments to outscore the Knights 14-0 in the final 30 minutes and came out on top 32-20.

“The adjustment in the second half really had to take place within our hearts,” Head Coach Peter Haugen said. “We were really jacked up at the beginning of the game and I thought we were going to come out strong, and we did in the first minute of the game, but it may have gotten us a little complacent. You have to give Martin Luther credit. They gave us some more man coverage than we anticipated, but we made a couple adjustments there and settled down in the second half.”

Martin Luther established its rushing game with 223 yards on the ground, but the Gustie defense limited the Knights to 84 yards through the air. Conversely, the Gusties had more success in the passing game with 248 yards compared to 106 yards on the ground for a total of 354 yards.

On the first play from scrimmage, the Gustie defense forced and recovered a fumble, which turned into six points four plays later on a three-yard rushing touchdown by Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, Ill.). But the majority of the first half belonged to the home team as it responded with three touchdowns over its next six drives. A 70-yard scoring drive gave MLC a 7-6 lead with 11:47 left in the first quarter. The Knights increased their lead to 13-6 on their next possession with a 10-play, 65-yard drive.

Early in the second quarter, Gustavus brought the score within one after a seven-play 67-yard drive, capped by a Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) to Hunter O’Bert (So., Eden Prairie, Minn.) two-yard touchdown pass. But the Knights answered right back by recovering a muffed punt and driving 23 yards in six plays to increase their lead to 20-12 with 2:27 left in the half.

The Gusties were able to put together a nine-play, 66-yard scoring drive on their last possession of the half as Veldman connected with Finch on a four-yard strike to make the score 20-18 at halftime.

After trading three-and-outs to start the third quarter, Gustavus got the ball back at the Martin Luther 20 ensuing a six-yard punt. On the next play, Veldman once again found Finch, this time down the left side for a 20-yard touchdown. The scoring play gave the Black and Gold a lead they would not relinquish.

After the Finch touchdown, the Knights had four more possessions, but each ended with Gustavus getting the ball back. Late in the third quarter, Veldman capped a six-play, 82-yard drive by lowering his shoulder for a six-yard touchdown run, making the score 32-20 which

would stand for the remainder of the game.

Martin Luther had 48 offensive plays in the second half, but the Gustie defense did not allow a score in the final 30 minutes. The Knights saw some success on third down, converting 11-of-23 chances along with 3-of-7 fourth downs. Gustavus was 5-for-10 on third down.

Veldman finished the day completing 20-of-35 passes for 248 yards and three touchdowns along with running one across the goal stripe. Brice Panning (Jr., Hamburg, Minn.) was his top target with seven catches for 143 yards and a long of 43. Finch had a productive day both on the ground and in the aerial attack with 13 carries for 57 yards and a touchdown along with four receptions for 43 yards and two scores. Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the defense with 11 tackles.

“We need to do a better job of taking care of the ball. That’s key,” Haugen said. “And we need to be better at the tackle point. We had a few opportunities to get them into fourth down and we just need to wrap up there.”

WEEK 2 • SAINT PETER, MINN. • GUSTAVUS 23, UW-STOUT 24 (OT)

Despite holding a 17-0 lead though 43 minutes of play Saturday, the Gustavus football team suffered a deflating 24-23 overtime loss to UW-Stout in the home opener. The Blue Devils scored the game-tying touchdown with eight seconds remaining in regulation, scored a touchdown on their first overtime possession, and blocked the would-be game-tying extra point to complete the improbable comeback.

UW-Stout outgained the Gusties 351-308 with 182 rushing yards. Gustavus totaled 210 yards through the air and 98 on the ground.

The first quarter proved to be a defensive battle with both Gustavus drives ending on punts, while two UW-Stout drives ended on missed field goals of 47 and 45 yards.

It wasn't until the Gusties' fifth possession that they found the endzone on a 14-yard touchdown pass from Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) to Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, Ill.) with 6:10 remaining in the first half. The Gusties took a 10-0 lead on their next drive as Sawyer Johnson's (Jr., Mounds View, Minn.) 32-yard field goal went through the uprights.

Gustavus's defense held UW-Stout scoreless on all six of its first half drives, which included 30 plays.

The home team gained a 17-0 advantage on its first drive of the second half as David Peal (Fy., Worcester, Mass.) capped an eight-play, 45-yard series with a five-yard touchdown run. The bend-but-don't break Gustie defense finally gave up a field goal with 1:54 left in the third quarter.

On their first drive of the fourth quarter, the Blue Devils found the endzone for the first time on a 15-yard pass to make the score 17-10. Each team ended their next drives on punts before the Gusties drove 58 yards in nine plays and were threatening to score, but the momentum quickly turned as the visitors intercepted a pass at their own 32-yard line. The Blue Devils proceeded to go 64 yards in 17 plays, capped by a four-yard touchdown pass with eight seconds on the clock, forcing overtime.

UW-Stout started overtime with a touchdown after five plays. The Gusties immediately answered with a 25-yard touchdown strike from Veldman to Ellis Hirman (Sr., Zumbrota, Minn.), but the extra point was blocked to end the game.

Veldman completed 20-of-41 passes for 210 yards, two touchdowns, and two interceptions. Finch was the top target with six catches for 51 yards and a touchdown. The junior tight end also rushed a team-high 16 times for 75 yards. Josh Kirk (Jr., Garvin, Minn.) posted 128 all-purpose yards, highlighted by 111 kick return yards. Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the defense for the second straight game, totaling 12 tackles.

WEEK 3 • SAINT PETER, MINN. • GUSTAVUS 13, SAINT JOHN'S 45

In the first home night game since 1988, the Gustavus football team dropped a 45-13 decision to No. 9 Saint John's on Saturday night at Saint Peter High School's Floyd B. Johnson Memorial Field. The Gusties drop to 1-2 overall and 0-1 in the MIAC, while the Johnnies move to 2-0 overall and 1-0 in the league. The game was moved back to 7 p.m. from 1 p.m. due to afternoon heat and humidity levels that would have warranted significant delays.

A 15-yard throw-back pass from Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) to Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, Ill.) midway through the second quarter brought the Gustie deficit to 17-13, but the Johnnies were able to add another touchdown with 2:24 remaining in the half and held the home team scoreless the rest of the way. A 92-yard blocked field goal return for a touchdown put the game out of reach early in the fourth.

"In the fourth quarter, we need to kick a field goal and that gets us within two scores, but it gets blocked and goes back the other way. There are some holes in our kicking game right now," Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "Our kick coverage was spectacular tonight. Kickoff return was okay and we punted okay, but the PAT and field goals have been inconsistent so we'll have to figure that out."

Tonight's result may not have been favorable for Gustavus, but it was more than a game. It was an event that brought together the Gustavus and Saint Peter communities. Gusties and "townies," the affectionate name for the locals, enjoyed an atmosphere that may never happen again. It was the first night game Gustavus has hosted since Sept. 10, 1988 when it beat UW-Superior 45-14 under the lights of old Hollingsworth Field.

Gustavus and Saint Peter High School also rekindled a field-sharing use that dates back 89 years. Gustavus had the first lighted football field in Minnesota (and perhaps the Midwest) and played the first night game in 1929. That same year, Saint Peter High School used the field and gained the honor of playing the first night high school game in Minnesota.

Under Saturday night's lights, the Gusties scored their first touchdown of the day on their second drive as Veldman found Josh Kirk (Jr., Garvin, Minn.) on a five-yard pass, capping a nine-play, 75-yard drive highlighted by a 50-yard Brice Panning (Jr., Hamburg, Minn.) reception.

The Johnnies carried a 24-13 lead into halftime and outscored the home team 21-0 in the second half. Saint John's outgained the Black and Gold 409-313. Gustavus did well on third down, converting on 10-of-18 opportunities.

Veldman completed 19-of-34 passes for 255 yards, two touchdowns, and an interception. Kirk hauled in a game-high eight receptions for 63 yards and a score, while Panning made four catches for 140 yards. David Peal (Fy., Worcester, Mass.) led a pedestrian rushing attack with six carries for 20 yards. For the third consecutive game, Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the defense with 10 tackles.

"I'm proud of the way our guys competed all day long," Haugen said. "No question that we've improved from week one. We just need to eliminate mistakes."
