THE SERIES: Saturday's game marks the 87th all-time meeting between the Gustayus and Concordia football programs. The Gusties lead the series 45-39-2, but the Cobbers have won the past two meetings. Turnovers proved to be the difference last season as Concordia erased a 14-10 halftime deficit, creating 14 points off an interception and fumble recovery to claim a 27-17 victory in Moorhead, Minn.

HOMECOMING: Gustavus is celebrating its 94th Homecoming Saturday, continuing a tradition started on Nov. 8, 1924, when the Gusties defeated Saint John's 33-0 on Hallander Field. Gustavus has enjoyed a good deal of success on Homecoming Day, compiling an all-time record of 64-27-2. In 86 Homecoming contests, Gustavus has tallied a 58-26-2 record against conference opponents, including a 10-3-1 mark against Concordia. The last meeting between these two teams on Gustavus's Homecoming came in 2011, a 37-20 Concordia victory.

LAST TIME OUT: The Gustavus football team suffered a 31-0 loss at Bethel two weeks ago. Bethel started the game with possession and was driving deep into Gustavus territory, but a fumble forced by John Krohn (Sr., Richfield, Minn.) and recovered by Kolt Gorg (Jr., Blue Earth, Minn.) gave the Gusties the ball at their own 20-yard line. A guick three-and-out forced a Gustavus punt and the snap sailed over Brayton Finch's (Jr., Mount Morris, III.) head an into the end zone, resulting in what proved to be the game-winning safety. The Royals ended their next three drives in the end zone, along with a blocked punt return for a score, and carried a 28-0 lead into halftime. The final score of the day came on a 28-vard field goal in the third guarter. Bethel outgained Gustavus 353-139. The Gusties were held to 84 yards passing and 55 yards on the ground. The home team also maintained possession for 35:36. Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) completed 5-of-20 passes for 84 yards and was sacked three times. David Peal (Fy., Worcester, Mass.) gained 26 yards on 12 carries, and Josh Kirk (Jr., Garvin, Minn.) caught two passes for 52 yards. For the fourth-straight game, Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the team with 11 tackles.

GAME NOTES

SCOUTING THE GUSTIES

Gustavus is aiming to snap a three-game losing streak today with a sense of rejuvenation after enjoying its bye week. The Gusties were last in action two weeks ago in a 31-0 loss at Bethel. The Royals outgained Gustavus 353-139. The Gusties were held to 84 yards passing and 55 yards on the ground.

Through four games this season, the Gusties average 17 points and 278.5 yards of total offense per game. On the defensive side of the ball, Gustavus has forced 11 fumbles and has totaled 380 tackles – third most in the MIAC. The return game has been a strength early in the season as the Black and Gold averages 19.8 yards per kick return, which ranks fourth in the conference.

Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, III.) continues to be a dual-threat for the offense after four games. The junior tight end/running back leads the team in rushing with 43 carries for 126 yards and a touchdown, and is second in receiving with 14 catches for 112 yards and four scores. Brice Panning (Jr., Hamburg, Minn.) has a team-high 17 receptions and 342 yards.

Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) has a 113.9 quarterback efficiency after playing all but two series behind center this year. He's completed 64-of-130 passes for 797 yards, seven touchdowns, and three interceptions. Inside linebackers Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) and Jake Boykin (Jr., Las Cruces, N.M.) continue to lead the defense with 44 and 30 tackles, respectively. Berkner's 11 tackles per game rank second in the MIAC.

SCOUTING THE COBBERS

Concordia suffered a decisive 46-7 loss to No. 3-ranked St. Thomas last week during its Homecoming. The Tommies outgained the Cobbers 390-233 while the home team lost three fumbles and was picked off once.

Despite the lopsided affair last Saturday, Concordia still boasts the MIAC's best rushing attack. The Cobbers lead the league in rushing yards (1,410), rushing attempts (243), and rushing yards per game (282.0). They've also gained first down via the rush a MIAC-high 69 times. With a strong ground game, the Cobbers rank second in the league in time of possession, averaging 33:23 per game. The offense as a whole averages 30 points and 368 yards per game.

Blake Kragnes is a dual-threat quarterback with the ability to pass or tuck the ball and run. Kragnes has completed 50-of-91 passes for 399 yards, seven touchdowns, and one interception, along with a team-high 48 carries for 153 yards and three scores.

The rushing attack is led by Rylie Sheridan with 31 carries for 402 yards and four touchdowns. Sheridan has the ability to make big gains with a season-long run of 91 yards and an average of 13 yards per carry. Dane Ringquist is the second rushing threat, averaging 66.6 yards per game with 46 carries and two touchdowns. Kevin Marzolf leads the receiving corps with 22 catches for 242 yards and four touchdowns. Andrew Thompson is the defensive leader with 33 tackles.

HALL OF FAME WEEKEND

Saturday's game is designated as Hall of Fame Day at Hollingsworth Field as the College's Athletics Department has selected nine individuals for induction into its Athletics Hall of Fame. The 2018 class of inductees include Renee Beaudry Scanlon '03 (soccer), Eric Butorac '03 (tennis), Meghan Donley Kimber '00 (tennis), Ryan Hoag '03 (football, track & field), Luke Speltz '03 (track & field), Andy Traetow'03 (football), Jerry Washington'03 (track & field), Kevin Whipple '03 (tennis), and Dr. Al Molde '66 (benefactor).

BACK TO HOLLINGSWORTH FIELD

Gustavus is playing at the friendly confines of Hollingsworth Field for the first time since Sept. 8, despite having a home game on Sept. 15 against Saint John's. That game was moved to Saint Peter High School's Floyd B. Johnson Memorial Field for a 7 p.m. kickoff under the lights due to afternoon heat and humidity levels that would have caused significant delays to the original 1 p.m. start time. It was the first home night game since Sept. 10, 1988 when the Gusties defeated UW-Superior 45-14 under the lights of old Hollingsworth Field, which was Steve Byrne's first game as head coach.

FORMER FOOTBALL GREATS ENTER THE HALL

One of the greatest return specialist in Gustavus football history, **Andy Traetow '03** earned All-America honors his sophomore season after leading NCAA Division III with 34.4 yards per kick return. The Jackson, Minn. native exemplified what it meant to be a student-athlete, receiving CoSIDA Academic All-America laurels his senior year. Traetow was twice named the Division III National Player of the Week and finished his career with 4,901 all-purpose yards.

Having only played one year of high school football, **Ryan Hoag '03** joined the Gustie football team in 1999 after transferring from Wake Forest. He earned All-Conference honors twice for the Gusties and is regarded as one of the best receivers in school history, ranking second in career touchdowns (29), third in career yards (2,232), and fourth in career receptions (144). His long reception of 97 yards is the third longest catch in the Gustavus record book. Hoag was the final pick in the 2003 NFL Draft, earning the title of "Mr. Irrelevant." He spent nine years as a professional football player with five NFL teams.

MIAC CHAMPIONSHIP ANNIVERSARIES

The Gustavus football program welcomes back to campus the 1953, 1958, and 1968 MIAC championship teams. The 1953 team went 6-2 overall (5-1 MIAC), the 1958 team went 8-1 overall (7-0 MIAC), and the 1968 team went 7-1-1 overall (6-0-1 MIAC).

FOLLOW THE GUSTIES ON KNUJ

The voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handles the play-by-play duties for the 13th consecutive season. Wheeler is once again joined by 1984 Gustavus graduate and former Gustie football player Ken Ericson on the live call of this year's games.

GUSTIES AROUND THE GLOBE

The 2018 Gustavus football team features a total of 100 players from 13 different states and, for the seventh-straight year, countries outside of the United States. Of those 100 players, 73 claim Minnesota as their native state. Five players call Florida home, four from California, three from Texas, two from Hawaii, two from New Mexico, two from lowa, and one player each from Massachusetts, Louisiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Colorado, and Alaska represent the Stars and Stripes. For the first time in Head Coach Peter Haugen's tenure, three countries outside the United States are represented in Mexico, Germany, and Ghana.

SEASON 102

The Gustavus football team continues its 102nd season Saturday at Hollingsworth Field. Over the previous 101 seasons, the Gusties have compiled an overall record of 496-356-21, including a record of 232-131-8 in Saint Peter. With 22 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) championships, Gustavus has claimed the second-most league titles in the 99-year history of the conference. Only Saint John's (32) has claimed more MIAC championships.

Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, is in his 10th year as head football coach at Gustavus Adolphus College for the 2018 season.

Last season, the Gustavus football team posted a 5-5 overall record with a MIAC mark of 4-4. The Golden Gusties started the season winning three of their first four games and averaged 36 points per game during that time. The Gusties bookend the 2017 campaign with shutout performances, beating Westminster 38-0 to start the year and then topping Carleton 52-0 to end the season.

In the MIAC's 2017 postseason honors, defensive end/punter Casey Decker (Sr., Mapleton, Minn.) earned first team all-conference honors. Second team members included Brayton Finch (So., Mount Morris, III.). Kevin Krohn (Sr., Richfield. Minn.), Matt Berkner (Jr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.), and Brendan Boche (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.). In addition, Hunter Johnson (Sr., Cannon Falls, Minn.), Karim Ortiz (Sr., Cancun, Mexico), and Michael Veldman (Jr., Becker, Minn.) earned honorable mention honors.

In nine seasons at the head of the Gustavus Adolphus football program, Haugen has compiled an overall record of 42-48 and a MIAC record of 30-42.

Haugen, who was the head football coach at Washburn High School for 15 years prior to coming to Gustavus, compiled an overall record of 111-44 during that span, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76–8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA guarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8–2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He has also served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football Conference and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early '90s. In his senior year, he earned all-conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Haugen became the 17th head coach in the 101-season history of Gustavus football in 2009. The Golden Gusties have a long and storied football tradition that includes 22 MIAC titles. The program ranks in the top-50 all-time in Division III (out of 246 institutions) with a 58.0 winning percentage (496–356–21). The Gusties will soon join an elite group of 57 NCAA Division III institutions whose football teams have won 500 games.

Along with great teams, Gustavus has also been blessed with many outstanding individual players, which includes 31 players who have received All-America honors, 16 who have received CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, and five who have received NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships.





It took some time for the Gustavus football team to find its footing Saturday in the season opener at Martin Luther College, but after trailing by two at halftime the Gusties made the necessary adjustments to outscore the Knights 14-0 in the final 30 minutes and came out on top 32-20.

"The adjustment in the second half really had to take place within our hearts," Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "We were really jacked up at the beginning of the game and I thought we were going to come out strong, and we did in the first minute of the game, but it may have gotten us a little complacent. You have to give Martin Luther credit. They gave us some more man coverage than we anticipated, but we made a couple adjustments there and settled down in the second half."

Martin Luther established its rushing game with 223 yards on the ground, but the Gustie defense limited the Knights to 84 yards through the air. Conversely, the Gusties had more success in the passing game with 248 yards compared to 106 yards on the ground for a total of 354 yards.

On the first play from scrimmage, the Gustie defense forced and recovered a fumble, which turned into six points four plays later on a three-yard rushing touchdown by Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, Ill.). But the majority of the first half belonged to the home team as it responded with three touchdowns over its next six drives. A 70-yard scoring drive gave MLC a 7-6 lead with 11:47 left in the first quarter. The Knights increased their lead to 13-6 on their next possession with a 10-play, 65-yard drive.

Early in the second quarter, Gustavus brought the score within one after a seven-play 67-yard drive, capped by a Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) to Hunter O'Bert (So., Eden Prairie, Minn.) two-yard touchdown pass. But the Knights answered right back by recovering a muffed punt and driving 23 yards in six plays to increase their lead to 20-12 with 2:27 left in the half.

The Gusties were able to put together a nine-play, 66-yard scoring drive on their last possession of the half as Veldman connected with Finch on a four-yard strike to make the score 20-18 at halftime.

After trading three-and-outs to start the third quarter, Gustavus got the ball back at the Martin Luther 20 ensuing a six-yard punt. On the next play, Veldman once again found Finch, this time down the left side for a 20-yard touchdown. The scoring play gave the Black and Gold a lead they would not relinquish.

After the Finch touchdown, the Knights had four more possessions, but each ended with Gustavus getting the ball back. Late in the third quarter, Veldman capped a six-play, 82-yard drive by lowering his shoulder for a six-yard touchdown run, making the score 32-20 which

would stand for the remainder of the game.

Martin Luther had 48 offensive plays in the second half, but the Gustie defense did not allow a score in the final 30 minutes. The Knights saw some success on third down, converting 11-of-23 chances along with 3-of-7 fourth downs. Gustavus was 5-for-10 on third down.

Veldman finished the day completing 20-of-35 passes for 248 yards and three touchdowns along with running one across the goal stripe. Brice Panning (Jr., Hamburg, Minn.) was his top target with seven catches for 143 yards and a long of 43. Finch had a productive day both on the ground and in the aerial attack with 13 carries for 57 yards and a touchdown along with four receptions for 43 yards and two scores. Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the defense with 11 tackles.

"We need to do a better job of taking care of the ball. That's key," Haugen said. "And we need to be better at the tackle point. We had a few opportunities to get them into fourth down and we just need to wrap up there."

Despite holding a 17-0 lead though 43 minutes of play Saturday, the Gustavus football team suffered a deflating 24-23 overtime loss to UW-Stout in the home opener. The Blue Devils scored the game-tying touchdown with eight seconds remaining in regulation, scored a touchdown on their first overtime possession, and blocked the would-be game-tying extra point to complete the improbable comeback.

UW-Stout outgained the Gusties 351-308 with 182 rushing yards. Gustavus totaled 210 yards through the air and 98 on the ground.

The first quarter proved to be a defensive battle with both Gustavus drives ending on punts, while two UW-Stout drives ended on missed field goals of 47 and 45 yards.

It wasn't until the Gusties' fifth possession that they found the endzone on a 14-yard touchdown pass from Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) to Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, III.) with 6:10 remaining in the first half. The Gusties took a 10-0 lead on their next drive as Sawyer Johnson's (Jr., Mounds View, Minn.) 32-yard field goal went through the uprights.

Gustavus's defense held UW-Stout scoreless on all six of its first half drives, which included 30 plays.

The home team gained a 17-0 advantage on its first drive of the second half as David Peal (Fy., Worcester, Mass.) capped an eight-play, 45-yard series with a five-yard touchdown run. The bend-but-don't break Gustie defense finally gave up a field goal with 1:54 left in the third quarter.

On their first drive of the fourth quarter, the Blue Devils found the endzone for the first time on a 15-yard pass to make the score 17-10. Each team ended their next drives on punts before the Gusties drove 58 yards in nine plays and were threatening to score, but the momentum quickly turned as the visitors intercepted a pass at their own 32-yard line. The Blue Devils proceeded to go 64 yards in 17 plays, capped by a four-yard touchdown pass with eight seconds on the clock, forcing overtime.

UW-Stout started overtime with a touchdown after five plays. The Gusties immediately answered with a 25-yard touchdown strike from Veldman to Ellis Hirman (Sr., Zumbrota, Minn.), but the extra point was blocked to end the game.

Veldman completed 20-of-41 passes for 210 yards, two touchdowns, and two interceptions. Finch was the top target with six catches for 51 yards and a touchdown. The junior tight end also rushed a team-high 16 times for 75 yards. Josh Kirk (Jr., Garvin, Minn.) posted 128 all-purpose yards, highlighted by 111 kick return yards. Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the defense for the second straight game, totaling 12 tackles.

In the first home night game since 1988, the Gustavus football team dropped a 45-13 decision to No. 9 Saint John's on Saturday night at Saint Peter High School's Floyd B. Johnson Memorial Field. The Gusties drop to 1-2 overall and 0-1 in the MIAC, while the Johnnies move to 2-0 overall and 1-0 in the league. The game was moved back to 7 p.m. from 1 p.m. due to afternoon heat and humidity levels that would have warranted significant delays.

A 15-yard throw-back pass from Michael Veldman (Sr., Becker, Minn.) to Brayton Finch (Jr., Mount Morris, III.) midway through the second quarter brought the Gustie deficit to 17-13, but the Johnnies were able to add another touchdown with 2:24 remaining in the half and held the home team scoreless the rest of the way. A 92-yard blocked field goal return for a touchdown put the game out of reach early in the fourth.

"In the fourth quarter, we need to kick a field goal and that gets us within two scores, but it gets blocked and goes back the other way. There are some holes in our kicking game right now," Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "Our kick coverage was spectacular tonight. Kickoff return was okay and we punted okay, but the PAT and field goals have been inconsistent so we'll have to figure that out."

Tonight's result may not have been favorable for Gustavus, but it was more than a game. It was an event that brought together the Gustavus and Saint Peter communities. Gusties and "townies," the affectionate name for the locals, enjoyed an atmosphere that may never happen again. It was the first night game Gustavus has hosted since Sept. 10, 1988 when it beat UW-Superior 45-14 under the lights of old Hollingsworth Field.

Gustavus and Saint Peter High School also rekindled a field-sharing use that dates back 89 years. Gustavus had the first lighted football field in Minnesota (and perhaps the Midwest) and played the first night game in 1929. That same year, Saint Peter High School used the field and gained the honor of playing the first night high school game in Minnesota.

Under Saturday night's lights, the Gusties scored their first touchdown of the day on their second drive as Veldman found Josh Kirk (Jr., Garvin, Minn.) on a five-yard pass, capping a nine-play, 75-yard drive highlighted by a 50-yard Brice Panning (Jr., Hamburg, Minn.) reception.

The Johnnies carried a 24-13 lead into halftime and outscored the home team 21-0 in the second half. Saint John's outgained the Black and Gold 409-313. Gustavus did well on third down, converting on 10-of-18 opportunities.

Veldman completed 19-of-34 passes for 255 yards, two touchdowns, and an interception. Kirk hauled in a game-high eight receptions for 63 yards and a score, while Panning made four catches for 140 yards. David Peal (Fy., Worcester, Mass.) led a pedestrian rushing attack with six carries for 20 yards. For the third consecutive game, Matt Berkner (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) led the defense with 10 tackles.

"I'm proud of the way our guys competed all day long," Haugen said. "No question that we've improved from week one. We just need to eliminate mistakes."
