2018-19 GUSTAVUS MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

SETTING THE SCENE

The Gustavus men's basketball team will put their five-game win streak at Gus Young Court on the line when No. 5 St. Thomas comes to town Monday for a 7 p.m. contest. The Gusties enter the contest at 10-11 overall and 7-9 in MIAC play while the Tommies are 19-1 overall and 15-0 in the league.

THE SERIES

Tonight's contest marks the 194th all-time contest between the two teams with the Tommies leading the series 118-75. The two teams met earlier this season Jan. 2 with the Tommies winning 97-53.

SCOUTING THE TOMMIES

St. Thomas comes into Monday's contest on a 19 game win streak, most recently defeating Hamline 108-58 on Saturday. The Tommies have a variety of players that pitch in on the offensive end with the duo of Anders Nelson and Connor Bair leading the way. Nelson averages 15.4 points to go along with 4.5 rebounds and 4.7 assists while Bair tallies 13.9 points, 4.8 rebounds and 1.1 blocks. St. Thomas averages 86.6 points and 17.9 assists per game which both rank first in the MIAC. Defensively they notch 7.5 steals per game and hold opponents to 29.7 percent shooting from beyond the arc which also both rank first in the league.

SCOUTING THE GUSTIES

The Gusties enter the contest winner of five straight contests at home, most recently defeating Carleton on Saturday 67-61. Gustavus has been solid offensively on the season shooting 46.6 percent from the field which ranks third in the MIAC, while their three-point percentage of 37.2 is fifth. The Black and Gold also dish out 15.3 assists per game which ranks fourth in the league. Logan Rezac has been playing well of late for the Gusties notching 14 points and seven rebounds in the teams win over Hamline on Thursday before putting up 15 points and six rebounds on Saturday.

LAST TIME THEY MET

ST. PAUL, Minn. – The Gustavus men's basketball team took to the road on Wednesday and was defeated by St. Thomas 97-53. With the loss the Gusties fall to 4-7 overall and 1-5 in MIAC play while the Tommies move to 9-1 overall and 5-0 in the conference.

After a slow start to the game that saw the Tommies leading 6-3 with 15:55 to play, St. Thomas went on a big run in the first half when a layup at the 11:05 mark capped off their 12-0 spree. After Nolan Malo hit a three pointer on the Gusties first possession of the game, they went on a cold spell and Malo's layup eight and a half minutes later ended the scoreless drought and made the score 18-5.

The rest of the first half was all Tommies as they outscored the Gusties 54-18 in the opening 20 minutes and made it tough on the Gusties early. In the half St. Thomas shot 58.8 percent from the field and 62.5 percent from the field while the Gusties shot 20 percent and had a three point percentage of 15.4.

After a tough first half the Gusties came out in the second half and outshot the Tommies in field goal percentage 51.6 to 50.0. Vannis Smith had a solid half for the Gusties as he tallied eight points on 4-5 shooting.

GUSTAVUS NOTABLES

HEAD COACH MARK HANSON



Mark Hanson is in his 29th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2018-19 season. During his time as head coach, Hanson has directed his teams to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2018-19 season, Hanson earned his 500th career victory with an 87-50 win over Macalester. He became the 46th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 16th active coach, to reach the 500-win milestone. He became just the third coach from the MIAC to reach the 500-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 497-263 overall record at Gustavus prior to the 2018-19 season, including a 377-184 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 30 players who have garnered 50 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the

Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached two Jostens' Award Finalists (Trevor Wittwer, 2008; Marc Newell, 1999), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter and has two children, Hans and Annika.
