



# ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA® TEAM SELECTED BY CoSIDA

## MASON NISSLEY OF MESSIAH, MIKAYLA BISIGNANI OF JOHNS HOPKINS LEAD 2021 ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA® DIVISION III AT-LARGE TEAMS

**AUSTIN, Texas** – Messiah University sophomore volleyball student-athlete **Mason Nissley** and Johns Hopkins University senior swimmer **Mikayla Bisignani** headline the 2020-21 Academic All-America® Division III At-Large Teams, as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA).

A finance major with a 4.0 grade-point average from Manheim, Pennsylvania, Nissley was named the Academic All-America® Men's Team Member of the Year. The Academic All-America® Women's Team Member of the Year, Bisignani is a molecular and cellular biology and psychology double-major with a 3.99 G.P.A. from Latrobe, Pennsylvania.

Nissley was named the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) National Player of the Year and an AVCA first-team All-American in 2021. He helped lead the Falcons to the Middle Atlantic Conference (MAC) championship, a 17-3 record and an appearance in the NCAA Division III quarterfinals. Nissley set a Division III record for kills per set with 5.69 and finished the season with 370.

A three-time Academic All-America® first-team selection, Bisignani was a two-time All-American and a three-time national qualifier in swimming, and was named the 2019 NCAA Elite 90 Award winner. She was also a member of the Johns Hopkins outdoor track and field team, where she was a two-time Centennial Conference Champion in the discus and placed 13th in the event at the 2019 NCAA Championships.

Among the 92 student-athletes selected to the Academic All-America® Division III At-Large teams, 14 men and eight women carry a 4.0 grade-point average. The 15 members of the men's at-large first team carry an average G.P.A. of 3.92, while the 15 members of the women's at-large team carry a 3.90 average G.P.A.

Nine men and seven women are repeat Academic All-America® selections, including three, three-time honorees. On the men's side, tennis student-athlete **Walker Anderson** of Hobart College repeated his Academic All-America® first-team selection from 2020 and received second-team distinction as a sophomore in 2019. Gymnast **Emma Schulz** of SUNY Cortland joined Bisignani as a three-time, Academic All-America® first-team honoree.

Other men's student-athletes to repeat as CoSIDA Academic All-America® honorees: first-teamers **Boris Sorkin** (Tufts, tennis) and **Rob Wuethrich** (Illinois Wesleyan, golf) were second-team selections in 2020, while **Gabriel Chicoine** (Norwich, ice hockey) and **Vishnu Joshi** (Johns Hopkins, tennis) were earned third-team distinction a year ago; second-teamer **Paul Rechberger** (Castleton, skiing) repeated his honor from 2020, and **Matthew Chen** (Case Western Reserve, tennis) and **Dylan Rice** (Christopher Newport, lacrosse) were third-team honorees last year; and **Cameron Marous** (Ohio Northern, lacrosse) collected his second third-team award after earning his first in 2018-19.

Other women's student-athletes to repeat as Academic All-America® honorees include: first-teamer **Erin Nicholas** (Middlebury, lacrosse and field hockey) repeated her first-team distinction from 2020, and fellow first-teamers **Ellen Gilbert** (Illinois Wesleyan, swimming) and **Ally Persky** (Washington-St. Louis, tennis) were third-team honorees a year ago; second-teamer **Kyra Bednarski** (Stevens, lacrosse) collected her second consecutive second-team honor and second-teamer **Ellen Druebbisch** (Lynchburg, tennis) was a third-team selection in 2020.
